

You have been arrested for a violation of the intoxicated operation laws, and under Wisconsin's Implied Consent provisions, I am required to read this notice to you.

You are deemed under s.

23.33(4L), [ATV/UTV] 23.335(12)(c), [OHM] 30.683, [motorboat] 350.103, [snowmobile],

Wis. Stats., to have consented to providing one or more samples and submitting to one or more tests of your breath, blood or urine, at this agency's expense, for chemical analysis authorized by law.

If you refuse to submit to any such tests, you will violate s.

23.33(4p)(e), [ATV/UTV] 23.335(12)(h), [OHM] 30.684(5), [motorboat] 350.104(5), [snowmobile],

Wis. Stats., and will be subject to an additional penalty, which is a forfeiture. The test results or the fact that you refused testing can and may be used against you in court.

If you provide a sample for testing, you may additionally request the testing facility to conduct an alternative test that this agency will pay for. You may also arrange to have an additional test conducted by a qualified person of your choice, at your expense.
