- 9. In this example, you'll see there were one resolution submitted in 2018 related to the keyword search. The year is important as you'll need to note it and it is the most recent date we'll want to use as this is how we determine if the WCC has a position on it. In this case, the resolution was supported with an **Advance** in the Recommendation field.
