Project Description Summary

Barron County, along with the recommendation and support of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources are proposing to continue rehabilitation of the Cattail State trail with this being the third and final phase. The Cattail State Trail is a year round motorized ATV/UTV Trail, and is also a snowmobile trail in the winter months when conditions permit. Rehabilitation will include overhead limb cutting and clearing to allow for quad axle dump trucks to spread gravel and a 6" gravel lift to the trail surface from Willow Street to 125th Avenue in Polk County. This will allow the Dusty Trail Finders ATV Club to shape and grade the trail on a regular basis, maintain a crown in the trail surface to avoid pooling of rainfall and trail erosion. Additionally approximately .2 miles of this section will have the width increased from 9' to conform with the rest of the width of the Cattail State Trail. Several areas of this section also have deteriorating asphalt on the trail surface which will be completely removed as a result of this rehabilitation. The Barron County Highway Department will complete the work. RTP will be applied for and if awarded the total of this request will be reduced accordingly.



Trail Project Detailed Description

Barron County, along with the recommendation and support of the Wisconsin Department of Natural resources are proposing to continue rehabilitation of the Cattail State trail with this being the third and final phase. The Cattail State Trail is a year round motorized ATV/UTV Trail, and is also a snowmobile trail in the winter months when conditions permit. Rehabilitation will include overhead limb cutting and clearing to allow for quad axle dump trucks to spread gravel and a 6" gravel lift to the trail surface from Willow Street to 125th Avenue in Polk County. After the gravel is placed the trail will be graded and then compacted. This will allow the Dusty Trail Finders ATV Club to shape and grade the trail on a regular basis, maintain a crown in the trail surface to avoid pooling of rainfall and trail erosion. Additionally approximately .2 miles of this section will have the width increased from 9' to conform with the rest of the width of the Cattail State Trail. Several areas of this section also have deteriorating asphalt on the trail surface which will be completely removed as a result of this rehabilitation. The Barron County Highway Department will complete the work. RTP will be applied for and if awarded the total of this request will be reduced accordingly.




