Project Description Summary
Langlade County proposes to replace an existing snowmobile bridge in the Phlox area. This bridge crosses the Red River on a major east to west connection on the south end of Langlade County. This bridge is over 30 years old and is in poor condition. The pilings/abutments are deteriorating and in urgent need of replacement. Temporary measures have been taken to keep the bridge usable in the short term. However, without a replacement this trail will have to be closed impacting 9.5 miles of trail and three snowmobile clubs in two counties. This would also reduce the Phlox Winter Knights trails by approximately $25 \%$.
Bridge costs to be split $50 \%$ Snowmobile, $50 \%$ Winter ATV. Langlade County Winter ATV trails open ten days after the snowmobile trails open. They are open to ATV only and only when the temperature is less than 28 degrees. UTVs are not permitted on the Langlade County Winter ATV trail system.

## Bridge Project Detailed Description

This bridges is approximately 30 years old and has deteriorating abutments and pilings. The deck is also in need of repairs. The weight rating of the existing bridge is unknown. Langlade County is proposing to replace the existing bridge with a $12^{\prime} \times 40^{\prime}$ bridge rated for $25,000 \mathrm{lbs}$ to accommodate modern grooming equipment. This new structure would be expected to have a lifespan of more than 30 years. No chapter 30 permits are required for an in-kind replacement see attached DNR correspondence. A zoning permit will be required for work taking place within a flood plain. Cost estimates include permits, the bridge structure, removal of the existing bridge, installation of the new bridge and disposal of the old structure.
