Due to heavy summer trail use and rapid acceleration at road crossings, damage to the approaches and the town roads has occurred. The damage consists of large potholes, along with blacktop from the roads breaking away at some crossings. In addition, the large amount of gravel being thrown onto the paved roads presents a safety hazard to road users. In order to stop the damage that is occurring and minimize the amount of gravel on paved roads at crossings, we are proposing to pave approaches at four different locations at this time, for a total of 8 paved approaches. The Town of Swiss will fund 50% of the project cost.




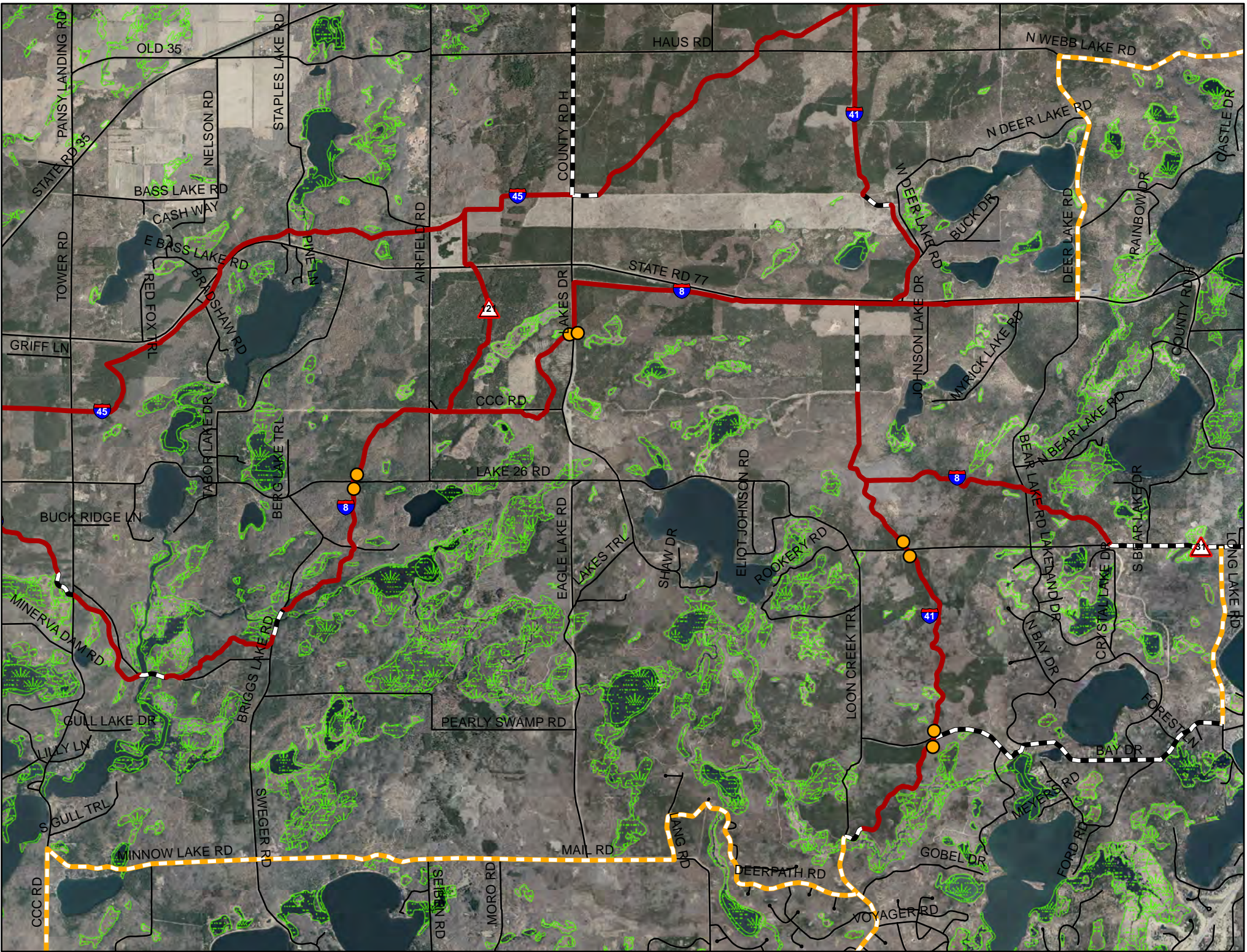
Proposed Paved Approaches on Burnett County ATV/UTV Trail System

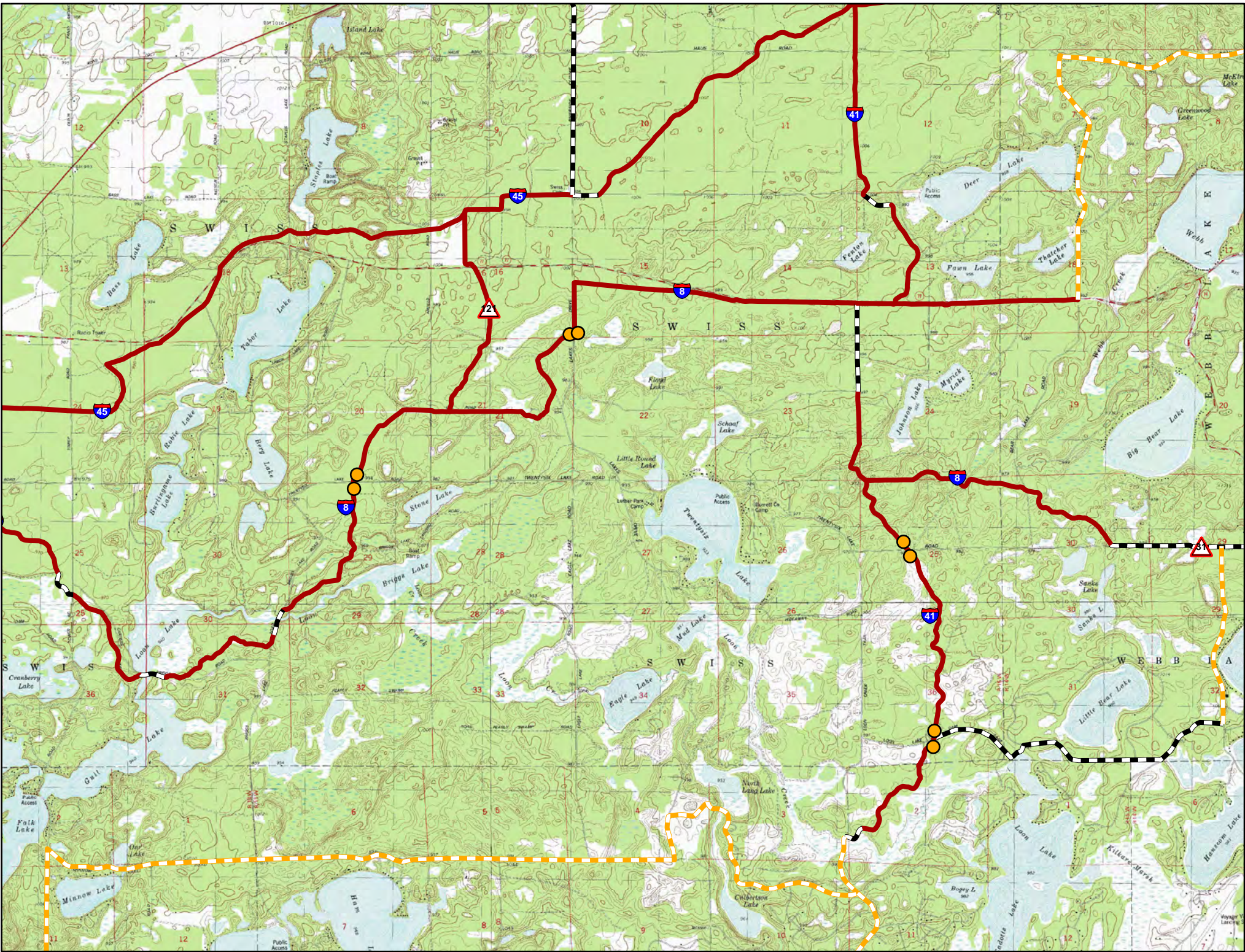
