Burnett County is requesting funding to rehabilitate 1.5 miles of Trail 925 from State Highway 35 to Trail 118. Trail rehabilitation work will include leveling banked corners; repairing areas that are prone to washouts; re-establishing a crown to promote water runoff from the trail surface; and adding gravel to improve safety and provide a maintainable trail surface. The trail is open to summer and winter ATV/UTV use, and is located on private land and county forest land. Work will follow Wisconsin's Forestry Best Management Practices for Water Quality. The work that needs to be done is beyond the scope of regular maintenance.

ATV trail rehabilitation funds were awarded for this trail in 2012. Funds were used to gravel the entire trail segments at that time. For this project we propose using gravel on problem areas and those areas that are in need of resurfacing.

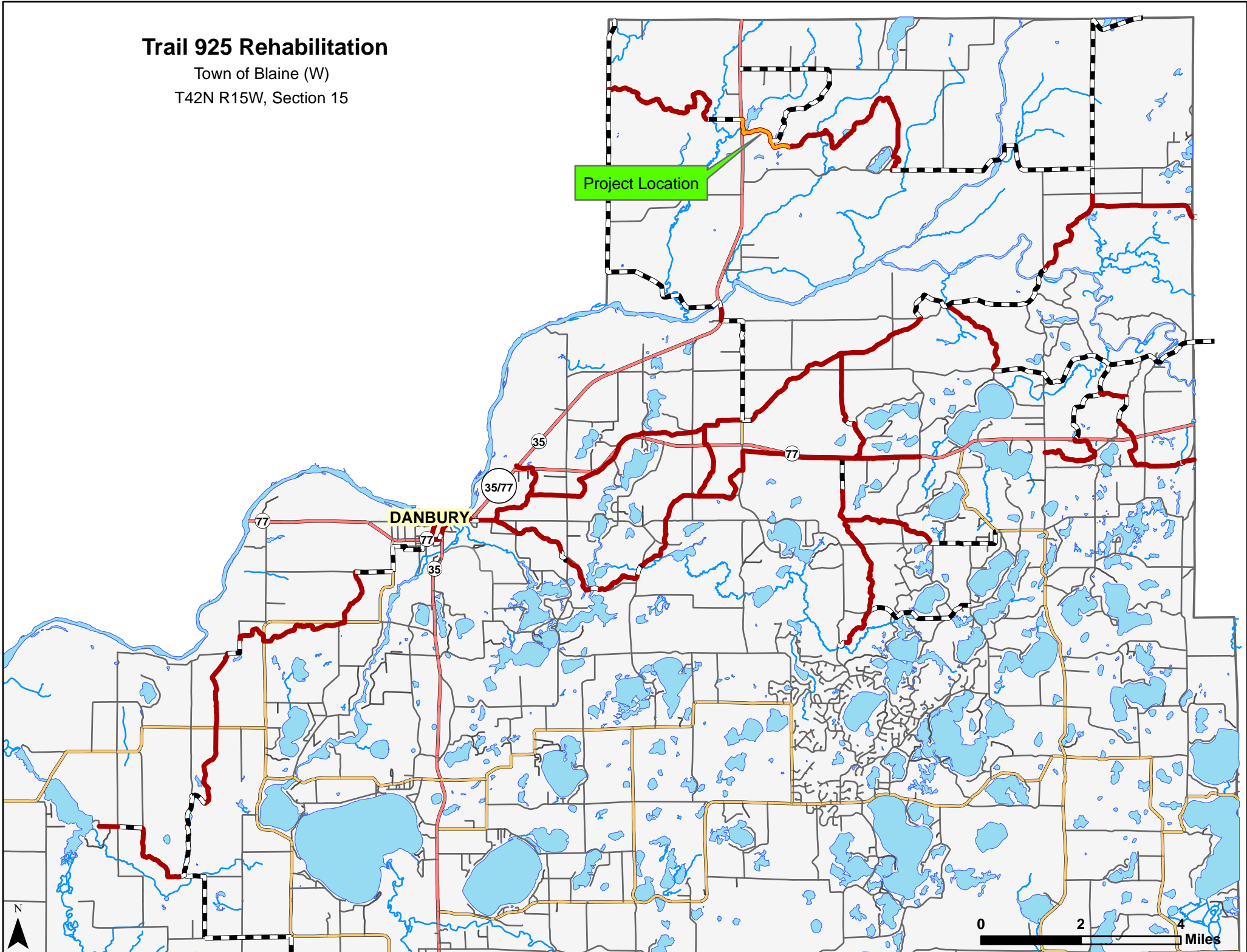

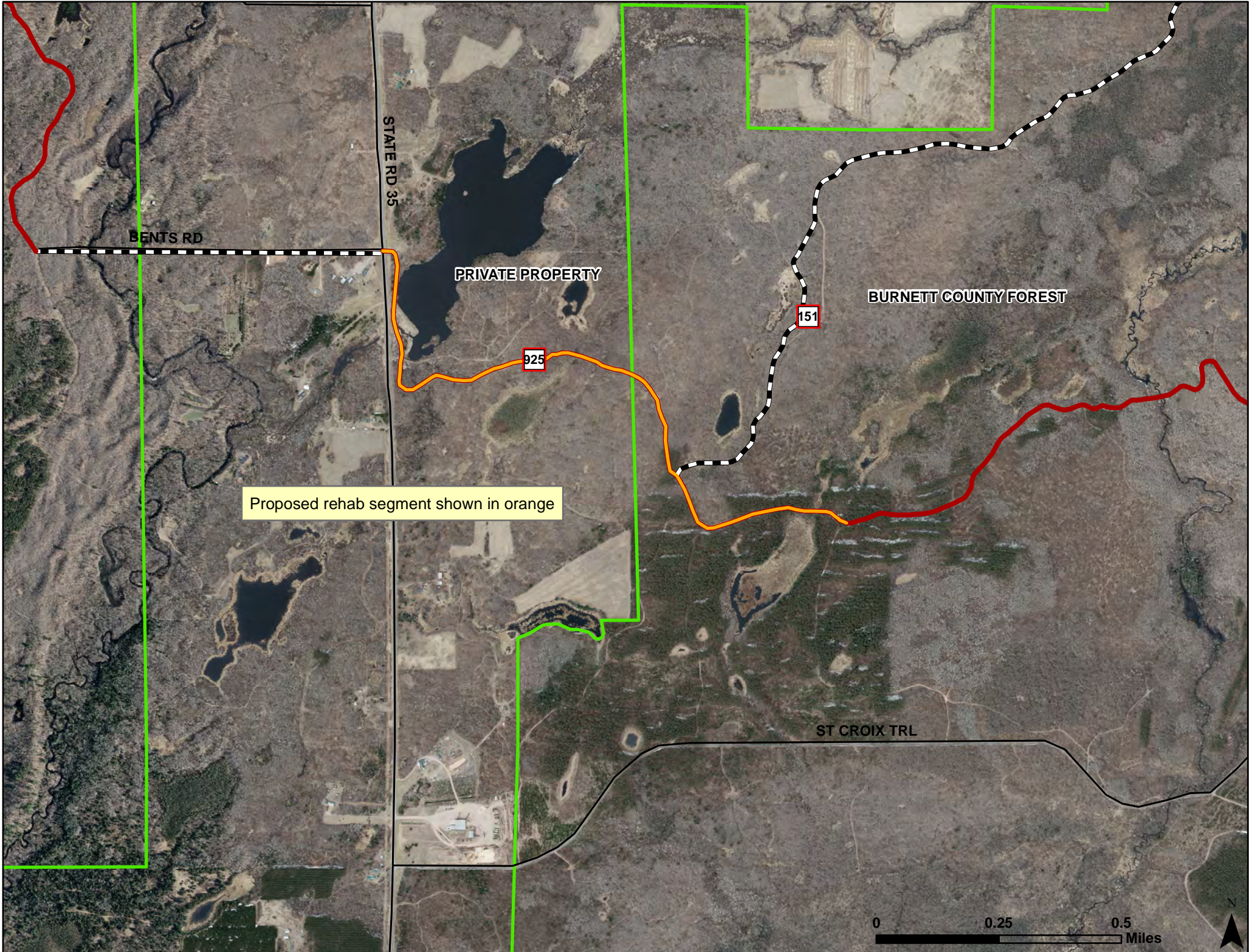

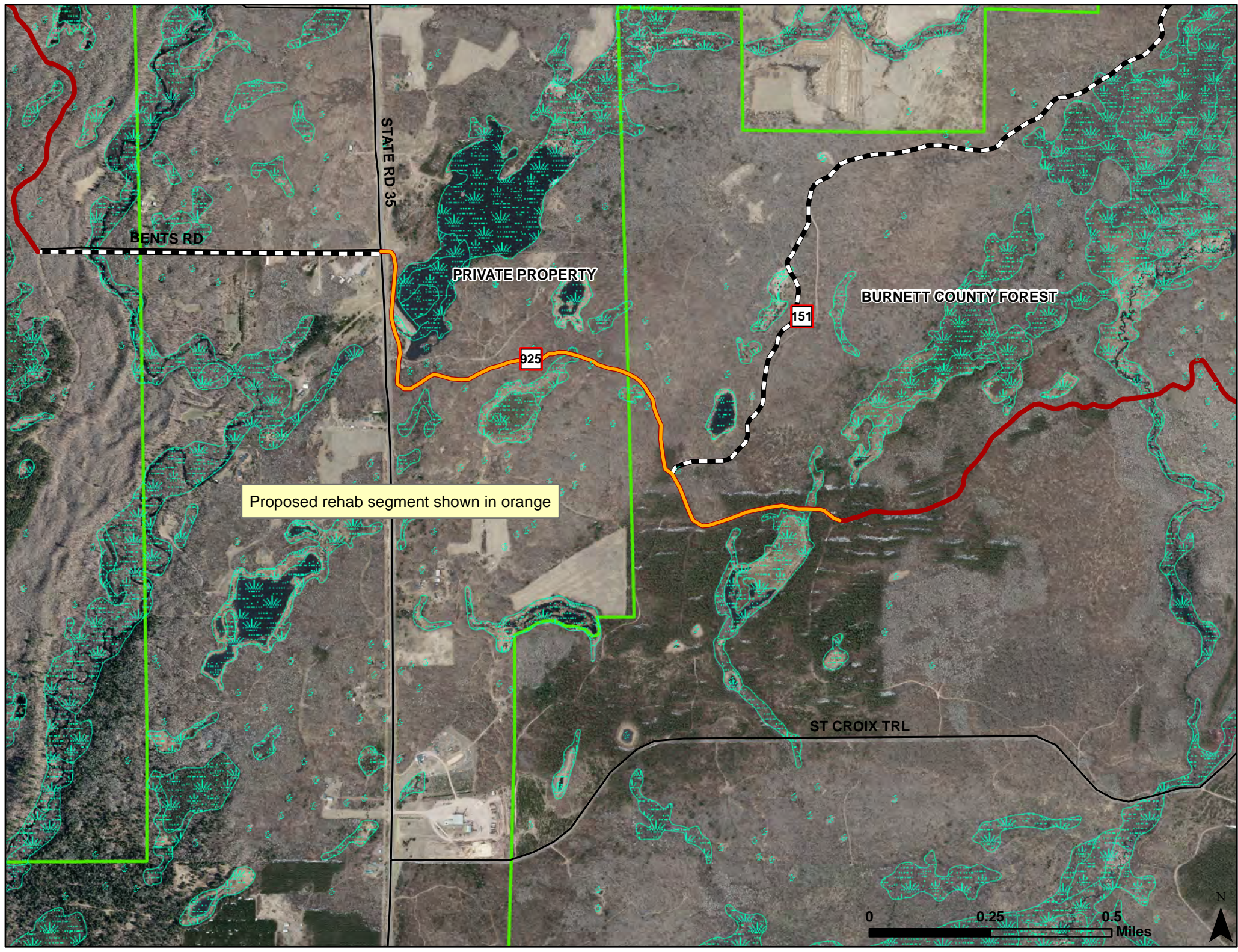
