Project Description Summary

Florence County would like to rehabilitate a 1.6 mile section of trail C6 starting at Jct. 18 (45.895584,-88.277394) and heads east to Buckeye Pit (45.893960,-88.247886). This is a year round accessible, dual use trail is open to ATV/UTV and snowmobiles. The popularity of UTV's over the last 8+ years has generated a dramatic increase in the amount of traffic using our trails. The result of this has caused a rapid decline to the trail surface forcing the need for improvement. There are several lengthy stretches of washed out, deep rutted inclines with several large exposed rocks creating significant hazards to riders especially during dusky hours. There is little to no material left to groom on this trail section due to increased usage, storms, and winter thaw. Erosion will be controlled by ditches and run outs where needed. This project will require 320 yards of crushed ore placed at 6" for a 1200' sand pocket and an additional 2200 yards of gravel to cap the entire work area. Materials will be spread by dozer then graded and compacted. We are asking for 80% (\$44553.07) funding from the ATV/UTV Program and the remaining 20% (\$11138.27) from the Snowmobile Program as this does provide a benefit to this dual use trail.

Trail Project Detailed Description

Florence County would like to rehabilitate a 1.6 mile section of trail C6 starting at Jct. 18 (45.895584,-88.277394) then heads east to Buckeye Pit (45.893960,-88.247886). This is a year round accessible, dual use trail which is open to ATV/UTV and snowmobiles. The popularity of UTV's over the past 8+ years has generated a dramatic increase in traffic using our trails. The result of this has caused a rapid decline to the trail surface forcing the need for improvement. There are several lengthy stretches of washed out, deep rutted inclines with several large exposed rocks creating significant hazards to riders especially during dusky hours. There is little to no material left to groom on this trail section due to increased usage, storms, and winter thaw. Erosion will be controlled by ditches and run outs where needed. This project will require 320 yards of crushed ore placed at 6" to remedy a 1200' sand pocket and an additional 2200 yards of gravel to cap the entire work area. Materials will be spread by dozer then graded and compacted. This project crosses Florence County and Goodman Forest property with whom we have a 2 year renewable use agreement which is set to renew again in April of 2025. This trail has been in place for more than 20+ years under the same type of agreement and serves as a major part of our system for both 3 season and winter users. This is a corridor trail that continues north from Marinette County and continues west through Florence County and into Forest County. We are asking for 80% (\$44553.07) funding from the ATV/UTV Program and the remaining 20% (\$11138.27) from the Snowmobile Program as this does provide a benefit to this dual use trail.

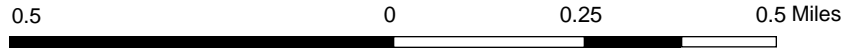




S.W.D.V. Map: Aerial, Wetland, Topo.

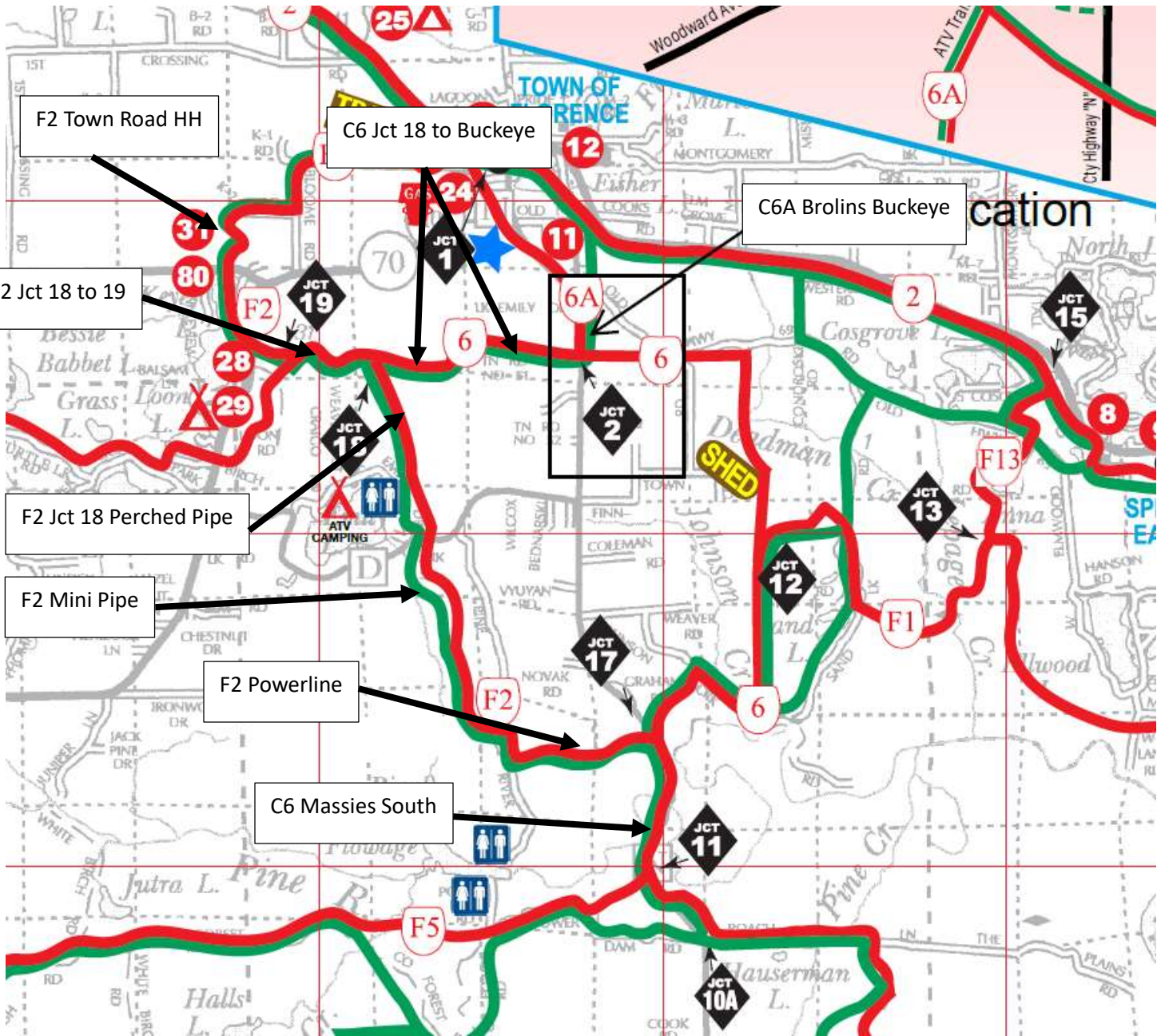
