Trail Project Detailed Description

This section of trail has had minimal investments since the trail was established in the early 2000's. Most of this section is native soil on rolling terrain. There are numerous hillsides that continually wash, causing rutting and erosion. Several years after this trail was established, the property was purchased by WDNR and added to the Beaverbrook Wildlife Area. The status of this trail has always been precarious and we are taking extra steps to assure that the trail surface is stable and maintained. The project includes gravel across approximately 1/2 of the trail length, with additional material budgeted, anticipating a need to "harden" the trail surface to support dump trucks during the rehabilitation project.






Trail 4, Wild River Trail to 53 - Wetland


