Vilas County is proposing to construct a new Summer ATV/UTV trail and re-locate a portion of the current snowmobile trail. A wider trail base will be established in the USH 45 Row to accommodate at least a 10' set back from the roadway and for a 14' wide trail required by the DOT. There are 2 storm sewer drains that will need to be extended. There is also one area on the trail that will require fill due to a sharp drop -off. This area, as well as the area along the wetland and USH 45 will be built up behind large rip-rap with pit run to bring these areas up to the trail level. Asphalt aprons will be needed at all road and driveway crossings per DOT. A 6"x14' gravel trail base will be installed. Funding to be split as follows: RTP: \$100,000; Snow: \$22,405; ATV: \$52,280






Vilas County Snowmobile Trails Hiawatha Passage



Vilas County Summer ATV/UTV Trails Hiawatha Passage









Hiawatha Passage Topo

Phil,

Thank you for the submittal. One item that needs to be discussed prior to a full review of the trail segment is trail connectivity. It appears that the trail is planned to end at a private road to Hiawatha Condos on the north end of the trail. This is problematic because WisDOT policy does not allow for ATV trail permitting that serves private business with no route/trail interconnectivity. The logical end point of the trail is Chain O Lakes Road to the north. The other concern is that it appears that there is some illegal ATV use of the right of way today between Hiawatha and Chain O Lakes Road. Construction of an ATV trail without including this area in the trail planning will result in increased illegal use of the US 45 right of way, and associated maintenance and safety concerns. WisDOT will require additional consideration for trail extension to Chain O Lakes Road, or some other logical terminus, prior to being able to fully review a planset and approve a trail permit.

Attached are our preliminary plans for the ATV trail along USH 45 north of Eagle River.

The typical section we used has the following elements:

- 1. 10-foot setback from the back of curb.
- 2. A maximum slope of 6:1 in the 10-foot setback from the curb and gutter to the trail.
- 3. A 14-foot wide 6-inch thick gravel trail with a 2% cross slope normal and maximum cross slope of 4% to match the driveways.
- 4. A 3:1 slope on the right side for 3-feet. After the 3-feet we vary from 3:1 with vegetation to a 1.5:1 with riprap.

The 1.5:1 riprapped slope was used to reduce the impacts to adjacent property owners and to reduce or eliminate the need to fill wetlands.

Our wetland boundary is approximated by our surveyor and should this project move forward we would look to contract with Vilas County to perform a wetland delineation to better define the wetland boundary.

The slope intercepts do drift out of Right of Way on the Johnz, Draeger Trust, and Oliver properties. The County would need to approach these landowners about the work out of the right of way. Would the DOT require the County to acquire easements for the disturbance?

The existing storm sewers at 23+40 would need to be extended. Currently the storm sewer at 23+40 end wall is partially plugged with sod. The storm sewer at 25+92 is completely plugged with vegetation from the wetland and should be cleaned out. The inlet in the curb at 25+92 show signs of water overtopping the curb and running to the wetland. If required a safety fence could be installed at the end of the 3:1 slope allowing a 3-foot clear area from the trail.

A DNR NOI would need to be applied for as the disturbance is greater than one acre.

Wetland fill permit may be required. Todd you may want to reach out to the DNR with the preliminary plans and get their feedback. We are very close from 25+50 to 26+25.

A preliminary probable cost estimate is included in this email.

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Good Morning Todd,

Thanks for the information, maps and plans. I remember being on site with you last year and seeing the wetlands adjacent to the proposed trail area immediately off the roadway's slope. I agree with Phil's statement that must figure out where exactly that wetland boundary is (by a wetland delineation), and then if any fill material is to be placed within the wetland this will require DNR Wetland Disturbance – Recreational Development permitting. I would say the next step is to get a Wetland Delineation completed to flag this wetland boundary, overlay the project design to that delineation report, and calculate that amount of fill (in square feet). If no fill will be placed within the wetlands, then DNR Wetland Disturbance permitting will not be required. I know we discussed constructing an elevated boardwalk thru this area to avoid wetland disturbance, but this is very costly and that must be explained in the Practical Alternative Analysis submitted with the Wetland Disturbance permit, all options considered to avoid and reduce wetland impacts (ie: elevated boardwalk, trail routed elsewhere, etc..).
