## Conservation Road ATV Trail Development

The Oneida County Forestry Department along with the Oneida County ATV Council would like to apply for a grant to develop approximately 1.1 miles of new ATV trail in the Town of Lynne. This new trail segment will add on to the existing Little Rice ATV trail system.

This trail will be on the footprint of a logging road and current snowmobile trail. The existing trail surface is mostly native soils and mainly dry except for a segment adjacent to Willow Road. A stormwater permit will likely be required for this project. A wetland fill permit will not be required since the trail is in the footprint of a logging road and snowmobile trail. No fill will occur in any areas mapped as wetlands.

The objective is to bring low spots of the trail to grade so it doesn't pool water and provide a maintainable surface. Approximately 0.25 miles directly adjacent to Willow Road will need a majority of the work. This section will have pit-run fill put down to bring the trail to grade then it will be capped with gravel. Other "hotspots" on the existing trail will be filled and leveled where needed. Three new sets of gates will need to be installed to prevent motor vehicle traffic during ATV season.

Oneida County is an audited and certified county through the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) and Forest Stewardship Council (FSC). The SFI and FSC standards include forest roads and motorized recreational trails that must adhere to BMP's and protect water quality. These standards address the layout, construction and maintenance of roads, recreational trails and skid trails to protect waters to make sure the quality of the roads and surrounding areas are sustainable and degraded.


**Trail Project Detailed Description**


