### **Trail Project Detailed Description**

Wood County Currently has ATV Intensive Use Area on State Hwy 54 and 5.1 miles south of Hazelnut-Kimball Road Connector Trails that are Funded. Wood County is wishing then to apply for 1.5 miles of New "Funded" Trail, north of ATV Intensive Use Area Parking Lot creating appoximately 6.6 miles of FUNDED, continuous ATV trail.





Thank you for sending this over for my review. I am attaching the mapped wetland and wetland indicator map in this e-mail. There does seem to be quite a bit of potential wetland indicators on the property. Any grading or filling as part of the trails in the purple or yellow areas would need permitting (or wetland delineation

demonstrating the area is not wetland). Like we have discussed with the snow mobile paths, mowing, and cutting of vegetation, as long as the roots remain in place, would not need any permitting from a chapter 281 perspective. I do also see mapped floodplain on the NW part of property. I would check with Brad Cook in Zoning to see if there are any concerns there.
