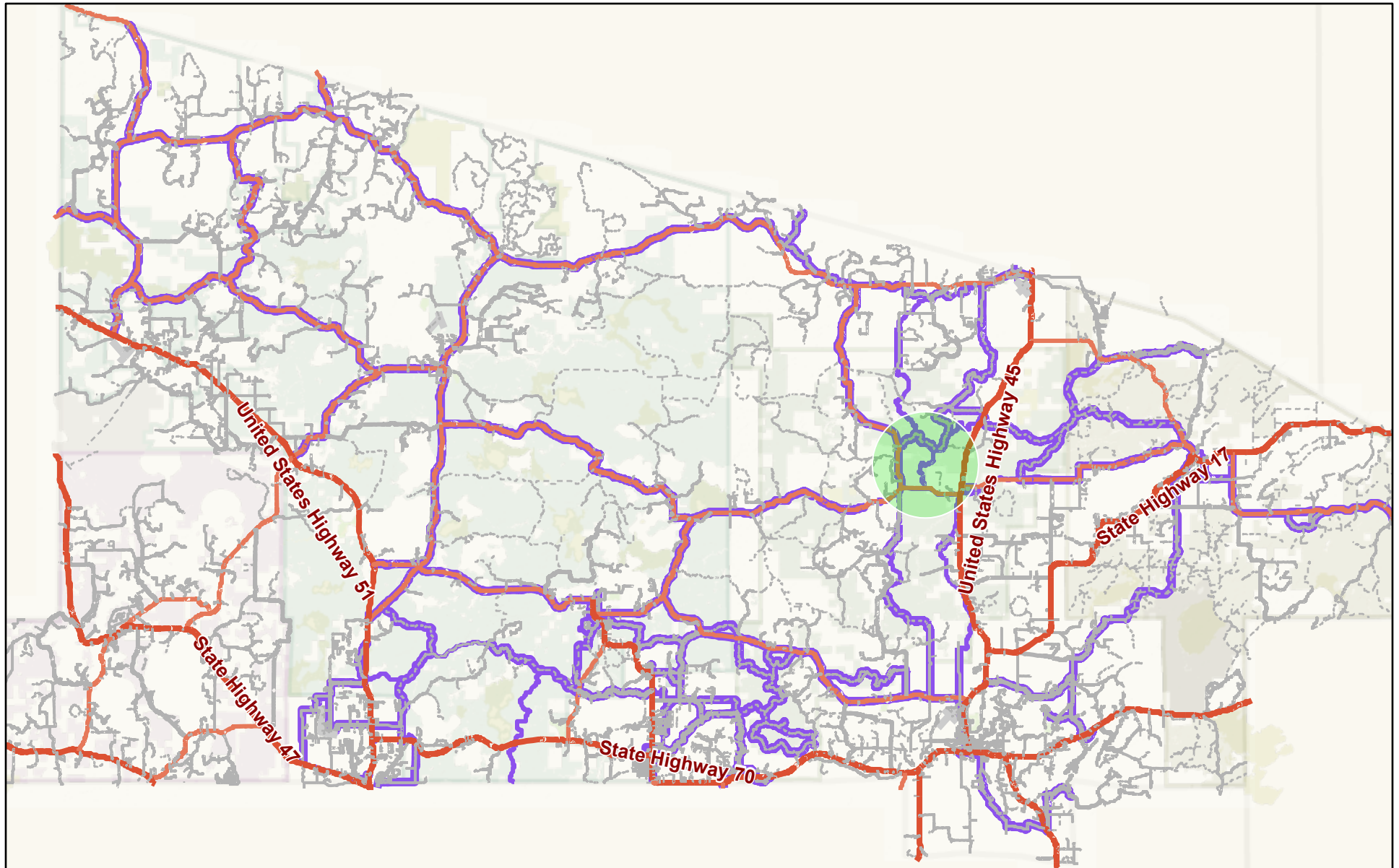

LANDOVER CHALLENGE TRAIL

- A) **Step Up/Step Down-** This station consists of 4'x8'x8" steps for users to crawl up on. 4 steps up and 4 steps down. These will be placed at the beginning and the end of the course. The steps will be constructed Out of 8'x8'x8" landscape timbers with pit run fill. This station will be 40' in length with a height of 4'.
- B) **Corduroy Trail-** This section will be approximately 200' in length using hardwood bolts in differing diameters.
- C) **Rock Crawl-** There will be 100' of rocks, of very size for users to slowly travers. This area will be on both ends of station D.
- D) **Water & Rock Crossing-** A 50' length for a water crossing will be installed with depths of 2'-3'. The use of pond liner will help keep water in the area and the use of a drain for when water gets to a certain level. Stones and rocks will be placed in the water for a fun and challenging station.
- E) **Teeter Totter-** an ATV/UTV sized teeter totter will be installed. The purpose of this station is to test your balance. Slowly drive up the side protected ramps and try to balance your machine. Slowly pull forward to the next station. The overall height of this station is 2'.
- F) **Tire Garden-** Tires of varying sizes will be laid and buried into the ground for users to test their skills in traversing. Tires from heavy equipment to automobiles will be used. The station's length will be 100'-200'.
- G) **Firewood Pit-** Fire wood pieces will be in a pit approximately 3' in depth and 50' in length. Split and round logs will be used for an uneven trip. Drain tile will be used to drain rain water away from the pit.
- H) **Rock Climb-** Using the existing grade, rocks of different sizes will be laid and stacked for an uphill climbing experience. This station will be between 20'-50' in length.

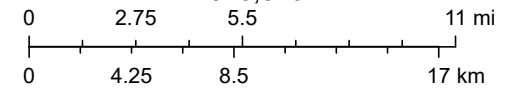
Vilas County ATV/UTV Trails and Routes

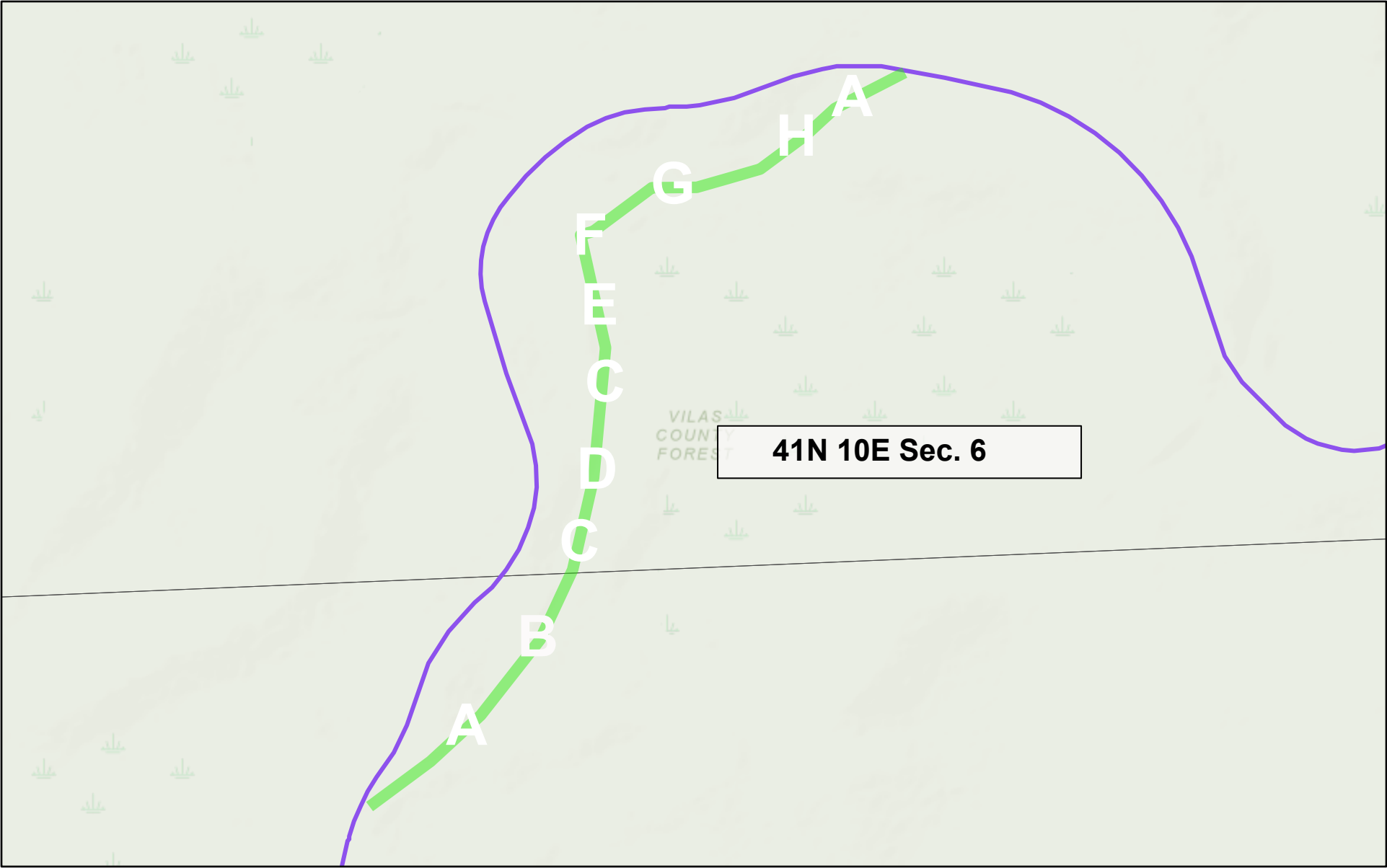

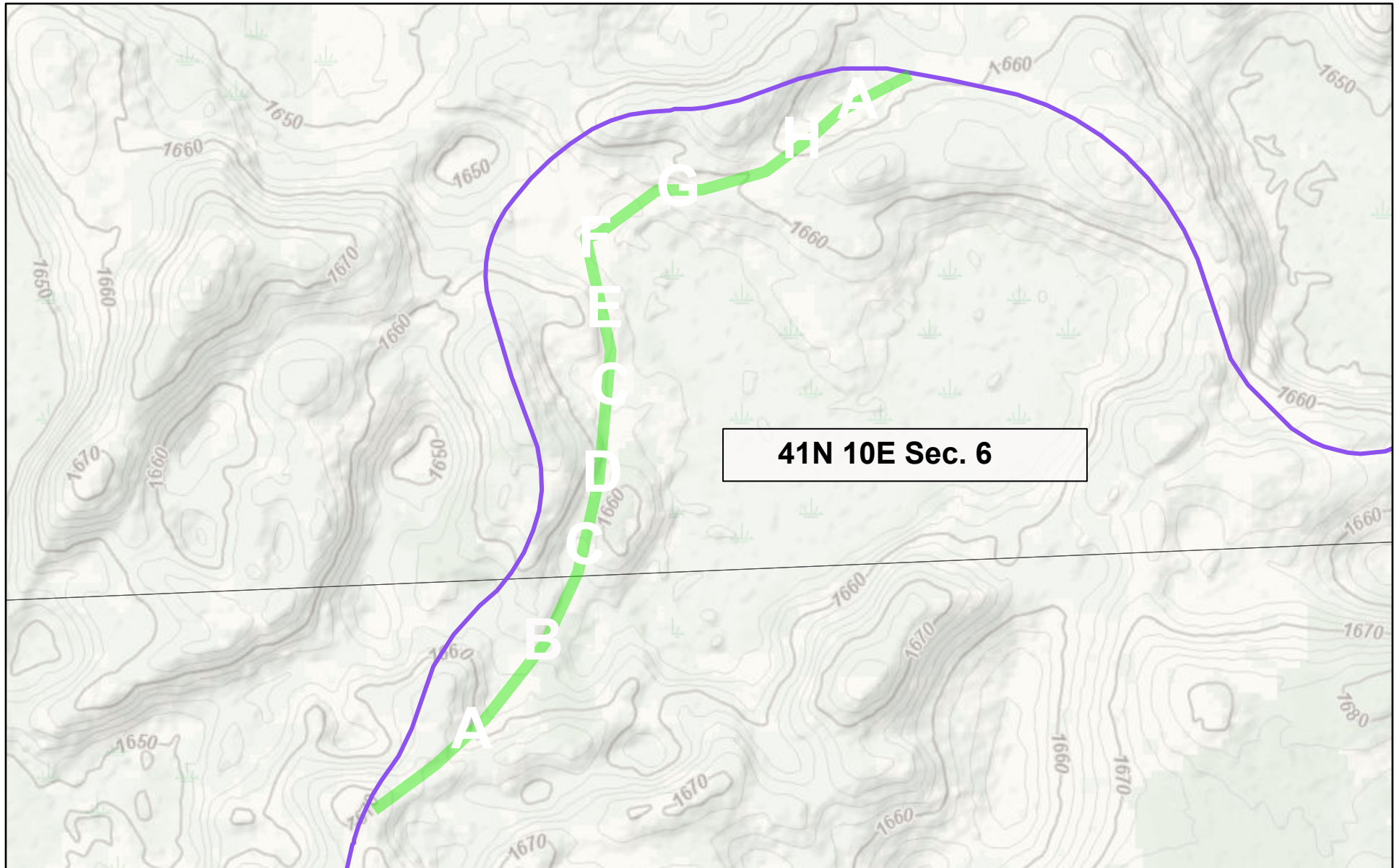

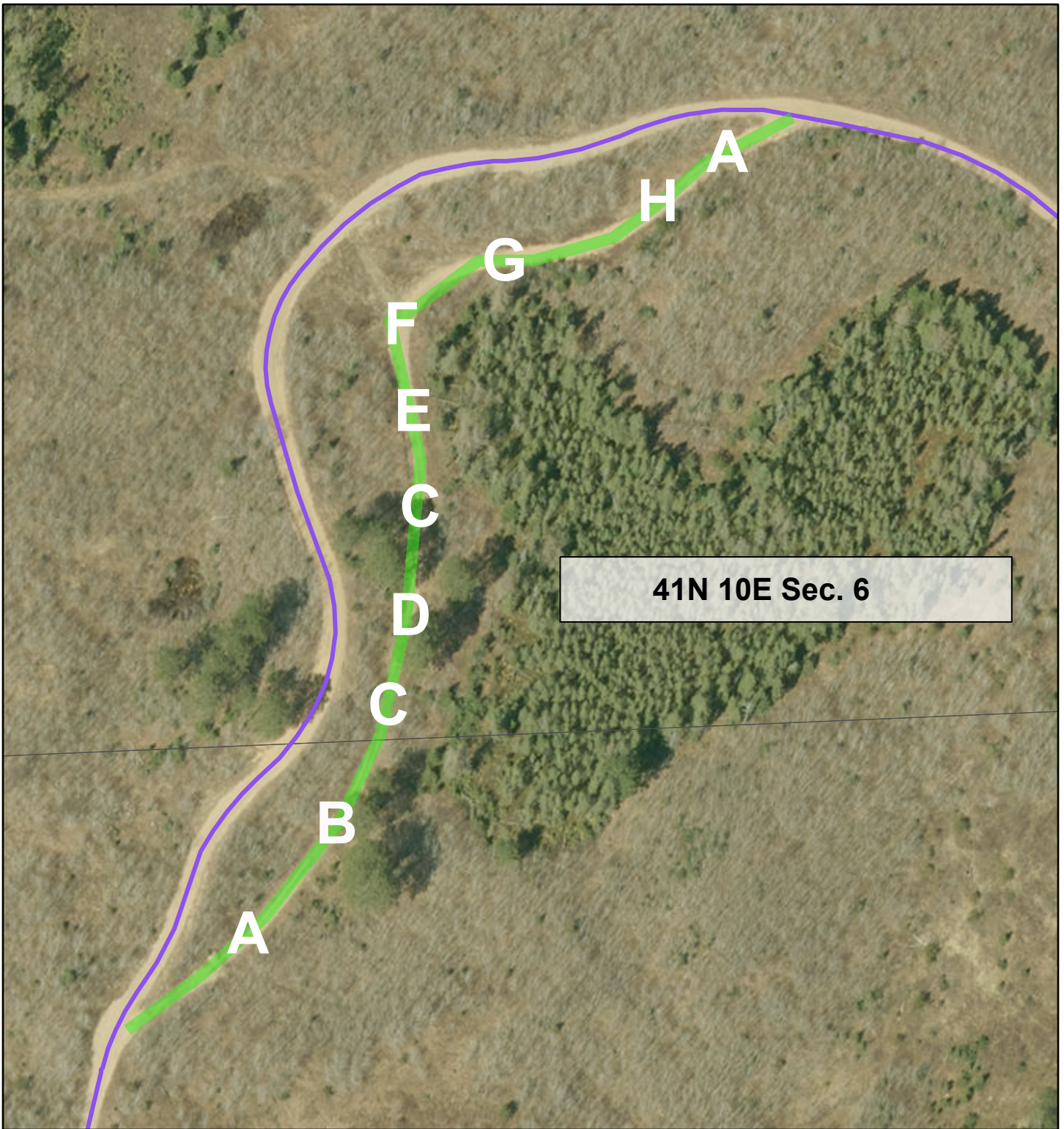

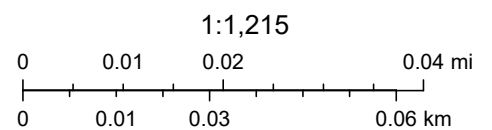
