








# Lincoln County 2024 Funded Summer ATV/UTV Trail With New Miles

This concept is a substantial improvement from the prior plan submittal. We do have a few comments within the plan for your review. As you noted below, there are still several items to work through once you have survey data to address grading, drainage, tree impacts, ect.

The main items that still need to be addressed are:

- -WisDNR approval
- -WVIC 30' buffer impact approval
- -Private property agreements
- -Highway cross culvert location, impacts, and overall trail drainage

Conceptually we agree a trail could be permitted once the above items are addressed. No permits to construct the trail in the highway right of way will be issued until WisDOT reviews and approves your final planset. Once the final planset is approved, WisDOT will draft a Memorandum of Agreement for the County to sign to construct and maintain the trail within the highway right of way.
