Project Description Summary

The Oneida County Forestry Department is looking to upgrade the two hand well pumps at the Enterprise ATV Campground. The campground was built in 2008 with ORV grant funding and County match funds. The goal of this project is to upgrade the hand water pumps to make them more accessible to everyone by lessening the force required to pump water. The existing steel rod in the casing will be replaced with 1/8" stainless steel cable and a new pump cylinder. The wells are 117' and 142' deep respectively.

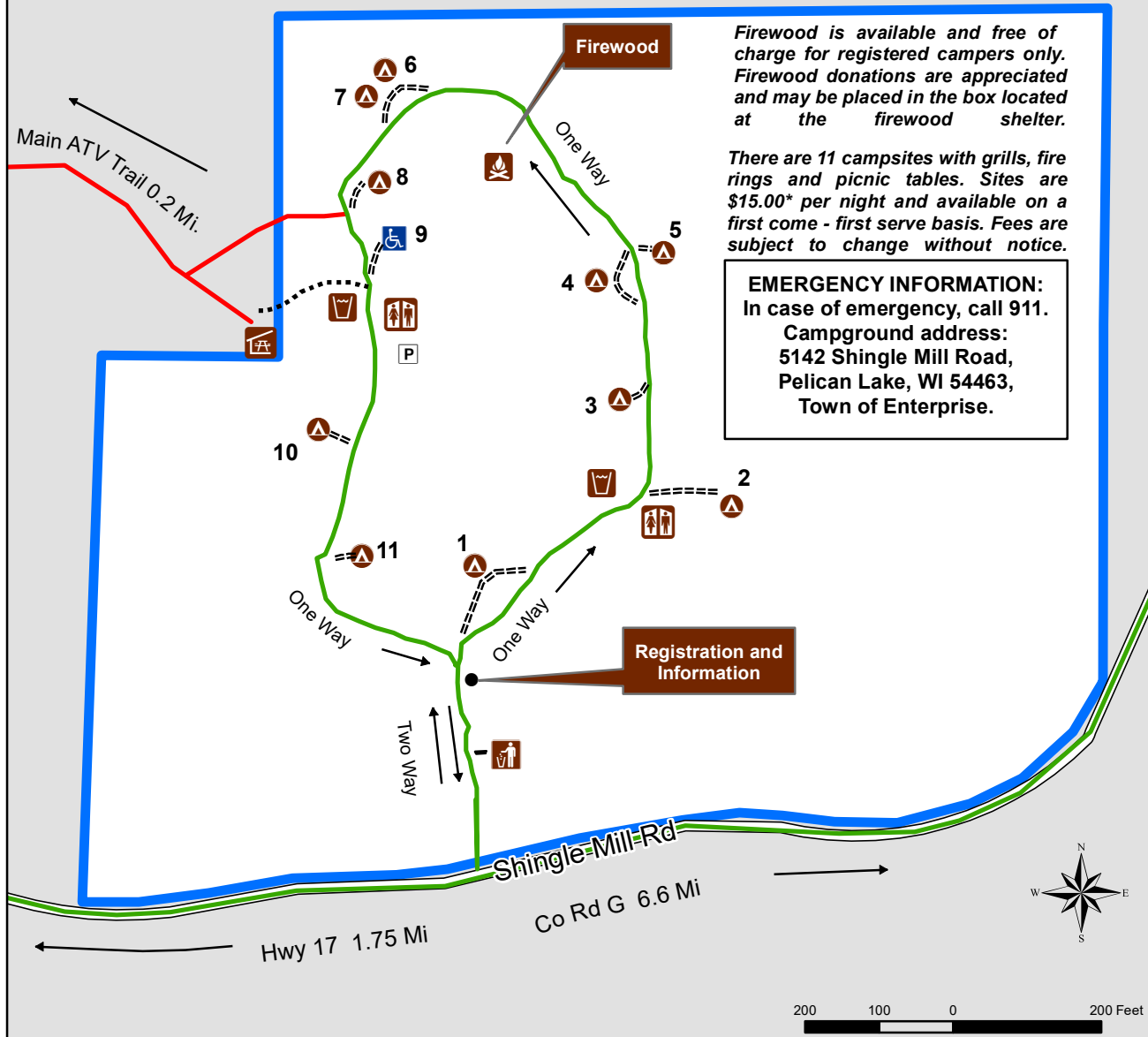

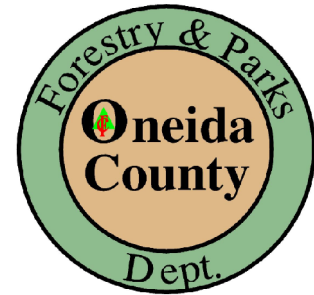
Firewood is available and free of charge for registered campers only. Firewood donations are appreciated and may be placed in the box located at the firewood shelter.

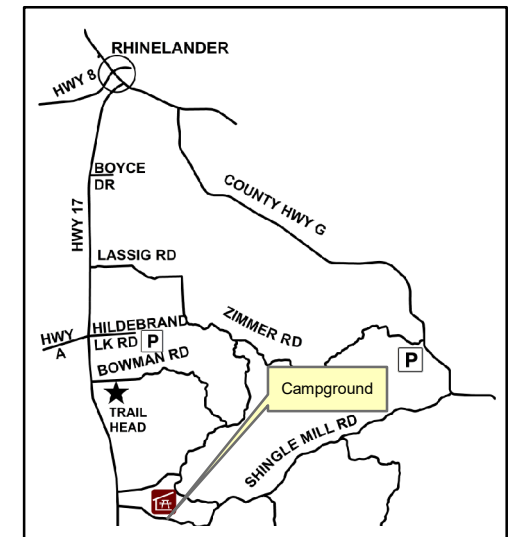

The campground opens on May 22 (or earlier) and closes on December 2. Sites are \$15.00* per night and available on a first come - first serve basis. Fees are subject to change without notice.
