Trail Project Detailed Description

This trail development will include reconditioning of approximately 1.3 miles of existing woods roads for use as an ATV/UTV trail in the Town of Wolf River in Langlade County. Trails will require a variance as the USFS requires a 16' wide ridable surface for use of UTVs. This also accounts for the volume of gravel needed to construct the trail.

Langlade County is working with USFS on funding to rehab the Troute segments to get them to meet USFS standards.

Work will include reshaping, drainage improvement, surface stabilization with gravel. Depth of gravel will vary based on site conditions at the time of construction and will range from 0-6" approximately.

Gate will be installed on the new trail segments to limit access to ATVs/UTVs as shown in the attached maps.

All sections of this trail will be signed appropriately as detailed in the trail signing handbook with additional cautionary signage required by USFS including: bike trail crossing, speed limits in narrow sections, caution of narrow trail sections (less than 16' where USFS allowed exceptions).

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


