The original application was approved 100% approved ATV/UTV funding to the total of \$83,652. Original application is included in this submittal.

Due to the changes in personnel and project resources, updated estimates were sought in which it puts the proposed project at a cost of \$175,100.

\$175,100 [updated estimate]

- \$83,652 [current approved funding]
- = \$91,448 [additional funding request]

Reasoning for the increased load limit is to ensure it is adequate for maintenance equipment and trucks hauling base and surfacing materials after any potential flood damages which have occurred in the past and is expected to continue due to proximity to the Pecatonica River. This load rating was also included in the previous application package that was approved.

Included in this application is a cost increase for bridge #18 on the Cheese Country Trail in Lafayette County. When Tom Jean was trail coordinator, he was working with another engineering firm, and we had an ATV club member that was willing and able to complete said work for the re-decking of this bridge within the scope of the original application. Following Tom's retirement, I have taken over the administration of the grant and found the engineer we were working with previously has retired from that firm. In discussion with another engineer from that firm it was stated that they were too busy to work within the grant timeline, so as a result we are now working with a different engineering firm to move forward. In addition, the ATV club member that was going to complete these projects has resigned from doing any further maintenance work on the trail whatsoever.

Ultimately, we have lost our cost-savings through planned volunteer labor efforts to complete these bridge re-decking projects which will now result in the need for private contractors and competitive bidding.

- 1) Perform an on-site condition inspection of the existing superstructure and verify girder sizes, spacing and overall structure dimensions.
- 2) Perform a topographic survey of the existing bridge site.
- 3) Load rate the existing superstructure with the assumed Wheeler prefabricated timber panels to verify the following load requirements.
 - Bridge 18 90# pedestrian and HS20 vehicle loading
- 4) Coordinate with prefabricated manufacturer for timber panel slab geometry and design.
- 5) Provide IFC (Issued for Construction) plans and specifications for the deck replacement sealed by a State of Wisconsin Registered Professional Engineer.
- 6) No permitting or agency coordination is included in this scope.




