Project Description Summary

Florence

Florence County would like to re-deck the Wisconsin Creek Bridge located in the Town of Tipler. This major corridor trail C7 serves as a primary connection to trails leading to the eastern half of Florence County and to Forest County located to the west and south ends of the county. This also connects to the State of Michigan to the north as well. Based on past grant information, this bridge has not received any additional funding since 2009 (ATV-1973) when it was constructed and installed. I have been performing two "Designated Use Inspections" per year as required by the State since 2017, one in the spring and late fall. These inspections include bridge, trail, signage and facility inspections of what is visible at the time of inspection and are non-invasive. The results are emailed to Mike Duke for his review and determination. We have observed the deterioration of the wear course over the last few years and now feel that it is necessary to re-deck. With building material costs fluctuating we hope that there isn't an uptick in costs. We have estimated the cost to be \$17,031.35 as of 03/27/2024. This includes the tear off, fasteners, machine time, labor, and disposal. We would expect that the deck to last approximately 10-15 years if cared for properly.




Attached is a copy of the last bridge certification that we have dating back to 2020. We perform 2 inspections per year on the entire NST that includes bridges and items that are relevant to the inspection form provided by the State.

Bridge permit should be on file with the Waterways Dept as this was a grant funded project from the 2010's according to our Administrator.

Miles affected (4.61) are based on using an adjacent road that is not part of the funded trail system. To get to the same point on the Michigan side greatly exceeds 20 miles.




