The existing bridge is an old club designed and built bridge from the 1980's. It is built on a narrow, double I-beam structure. The main beams are approx. 6' apart from outside to outside. It may have been designed to accommodate the old Tucker grooming unit used back then. The trail is now groomed by larger, heavier, tracked tractors. These have a wider wheelbase of approx. 8' so there is no main structure under the groomer. The wooden deck and the 3x3 square tubing spaced every 6 feet for the railing is what is holding the groomer from falling through. The abutment/base is wooden treated poles buried in the ground. These poles are also narrowly spaced. There is very little rip-rap remaining protecting the support and bridge. The wooden deck is rotten and is in bad shape. I do not know when the last funded work was done on this bridge but was told it is beyond ten years. The condition of the deck suggest it is much longer than 10 years. Bridge Project Detailed Description

The existing bridge is an old club designed and built bridge from the 1980's. It is built on a narrow, double I-beam structure. The main beams are approximately 6 feet apart from outside to outside. It may have been designed to accommodate the old Tucker grooming unit used back then. The trail is now groomed by larger, heavier, tracked tractors. These have a wider wheelbase of approximately 8' so there is no main structure under the groomer. The wooden deck and the 3x3 square tubing spaced every 6 feet for the railing is what is holding the groomer from falling through. The abutment/base is wooden treated poles buried in the ground. They look like old telephone poles. These poles are also narrowly spaced. There is very little rip-rap remaining protecting the support and bridge. The wooden deck is rotten and is in bad shape. I do not know when the last funded work was done on this bridge but was told it is beyond ten years. The condition of the deck suggest it is much longer than 10 years. Due to the condition of the bridge the groomer is no longer allowed to cross the bridge adding on additional back tracking to go around.

The project consist of removing the existing bridge, removing some large trees and stumps washed up against the existing support, placing a new abutment and rip rap and setting a new steel truss clear span bridge. If the bridge is not replaced a re-deck grant would be required.






Bridge Location Map




Structure Specific Notes

Structure is a steel girder Bridge. 18"x 7.5" x 1/2" Steel girders. There is some distortion of the west girder, minor section loss and freckled rust widesproad on both girders. Abut ment are 11" round pilings topped with 12" x 8" x 1/2 I-beam. Good condition. The wooden deck is in very pour condition, with severe decay on many of the boards. Deck should be replaced. Channel is in good condition.




