Bridge Project Detailed Description

The old bridge will be removed and hauled away. A new 12' X 60' arched steel truss bridge made by Anderson Bridges would be constructed with #1 southern yellow pine deck and horizontal safety rails with a 4" opening . The proposed new bridge will sit higher over the stream, meeting all WI DNR waterway permitting requirements, and the extended length will reach beyond the banks to provide a sound footing for the abutments. The bridge will have a load capacity of 25,000 pounds which will allow for more flexibility for larger maintenance equipment. When funding is secured, plans will be finalized and Ch. 30 permit will be obtained from WI DNR.

If the bridge were to not receive funding to be replaced, it will most likely need to be closed in the near future. This would effectively close 3.5 miles of funded trail and re-routing would be near to impossible due to the surrounding terrain and most landowners to be non-cooperative with snowmobiling use.




