The current surface of the bridge deck is in rough shape and could cause harm to multiple different user groups that use the trail system. The deck is worn, splintering, warped, screws missing and in some places holes in the deck. These issues could cause an uneven riding surface causing a hazard for those who are crossing the bridge. Photos will be attached demonstrating the need for a new deck surface on the Swamp Creek Bridge.






