

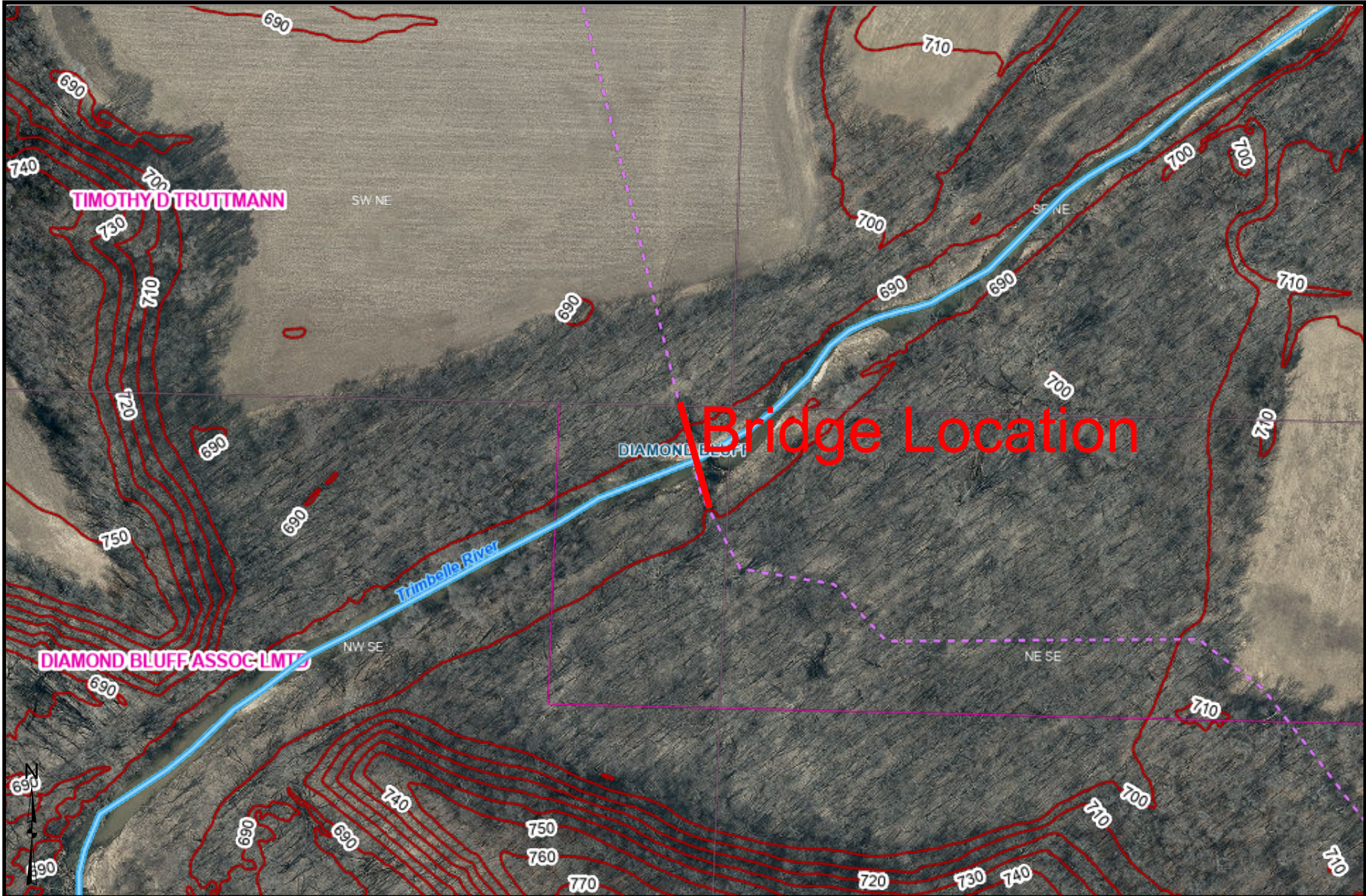







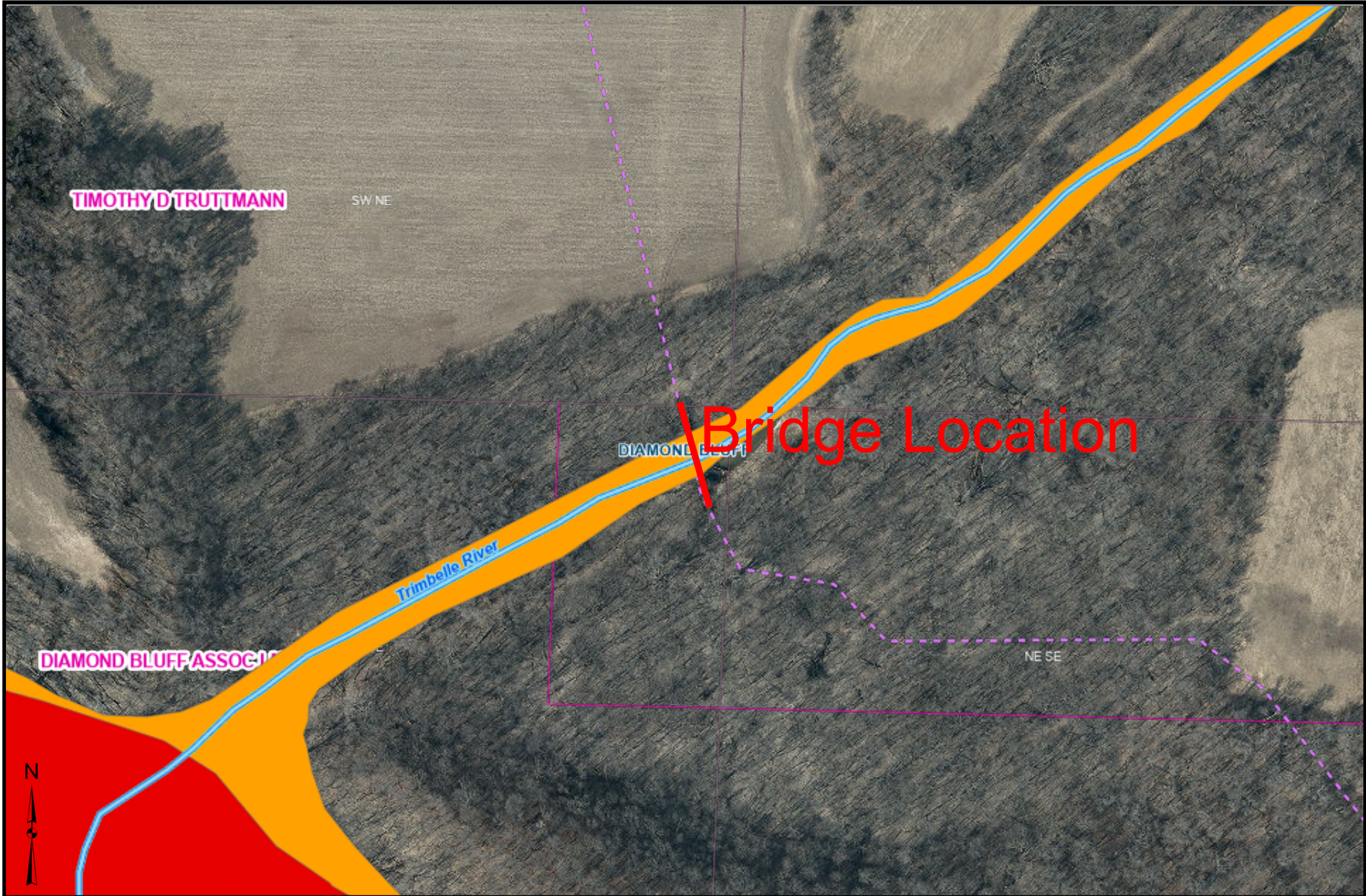
The bottom of the bridge and ramps show many dark/black areas that are rotten that do not show on the topside.

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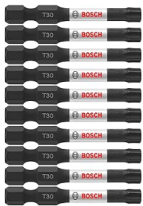
