**Project Description Summary** 

Lincoln County is requesting funding to complete a mandatory reroute for a segment of our 39 Snowmobile Trail. A recent loss of a private land easement will cause the trail to close if the trail is not relocated. The 39 Trail is a very important trail that travels between the two largest cities in Lincoln County, Merrill and Tomahawk. The segment in question parallels the west side of Hwy 51 near the boundary of the state right of way(ROW) and private land. Most of the trail is located on the state ROW, but it deviates slightly onto the private property in a few locations due to difficult topography and utility poles. Since the private landowner who pulled the easement owns 1 mile of frontage at this location rerouting options are limited. The best solution is to relocated the trail so that all of it is located on the state ROW. This reroute will have no effect on the total miles of funded trail. The funds being applied for will help to pay for grading work, fill material, a culvert, and moving the ROW fence in a few locations. We are currently working out the details of this project with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation(WDOT). The cost estimate is a rough estimate that we are hoping to refine as the project details are worked out with WDOT.
