Trail Project Detailed Description					

Burnett County requests funding to reroute a segment of Trail 45 east of Danbury, on the north side of Lake 26 Rd. The existing trail segment has sharp corners with steep, sandy banks that cause visibility concerns and maintenance issues. We propose constructing approximately 300' of new trail and abandoning the old trail segment to eliminate the corners and provide a safer trail. Trail 45 is a main corridor in our county, and this segment receives heavy year-round use. Due to the very sandy soils in this area, the new trail segment will be surfaced with 6-8" of gravel to provide a maintainable base.

ATV trail rehabilitation funds were awarded for this trail in 2018 as part of a larger project to address problem areas over 5.5 miles of trail.

We are applying for RTP funding in the amount of 80% of the project cost. We are requesting to split the remainder of the project 50/50 between Snowmobile and ATV.
