Project Description Summary

Forest County is submitting funding request to install a poly-coated arched culvert on a Forest County Funded Snowmobile Trail located near Ada Lake and Glade Lake on Forest Service Road 2042. The culvert is located on USFS property and was requested by USFS to install a culvert in this location. Installation of this culvert will prevent over flow of water on Forest Road 2042 or washing it out. Forest Service road 2042 has had numerous years of washout and flooding due to the large water shed from Glade Lake. Additionally, fill will need to be placed farther down the trail to prevent additional wash outs farther down the trail. Forest Service Staff have completed necessary NEPA studies but also had watershed specialist to ensure this is the corrective action for this trail.

Trail Project Detailed Description

Project site is near Ada Lake and Glade Lake on Forest Service Road 2042 needs a 64"x43"x32' polycoated pipe arch culvert. We will need to block the a ditch along the road to avoid water diverting to the southeast. Additionally, fill the scour hole caused by water diverting to the south east currently and install a culvert about 100' to the northwest of where the water currently crosses in location shown in attached. Culvert pipe will be buried invert 1' below the existing wetland surface elevation. Backfill will be compacted and at least 1.5' of fill must be placed over the culvert. Exposed soil side slopes will be stabilized with seed and straw or erosion control blanket. A local borrow site for fill material may be utilized if approved by the FS prior. There was also a hole in the fill on the west end of the wetland crossing that needs filling to prevent water from over topping there rather than traveling to the culvert.



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



Travis- Below is a summary of proposed work put together a while ago. Attached is a picture of what we are proposing and another showing the ditch to block.

The site near Ada Lake on FR 2042 needs a 64"x43"x32' polycoated pipe arch culvert. They will need to block the ditch to avoid water diverting to the southeast, fill the scour hole caused by water diverting to the south east currently and install a culvert about 100' to the northwest of where the water currently crosses in location shown in attached "FR2042_snowtrail_GladeLkOutlet_Proposed_work.docx". They should bury the pipe invert 1' below the existing wetland surface elevation. Backfill must be compacted and at least 1.5' of fill must be placed over the culvert. Exposed soil side slopes must be stabilized with seed and straw or erosion control blanket. A local borrow site for fill material may be utilized if approved by the FS prior. There was also a hole in the fill on the west end of the wetland crossing that needs filling to prevent water from overtopping there rather than traveling to the culvert.

Hi Travis-

I just wanted to touch base with you on the Glade Lake outlet wetland crossing at FR 2042, snowmobile trail. When we met out in the field, we discussed that Forest Service needed to complete necessary NEPA requirements this winter. This is in process. We also discussed this project would be submitted for trail grant funding. And then this is where my memory is fuzzy. I believe the Forest was going to provide a culvert size/rough cost estimate so the County could apply for trail grant dollars. Is this correct or am I missing something?

Related to this site we discussed replacing the culvert at Ada Lake outlet /Langlade County snowmobile trail. The Forest had to bump a few projects around and plan to replace this culvert in 2026.

Please let me know if I am missing anything for the Glade lake outlet crossing; I want to make sure we keep things moving along.
