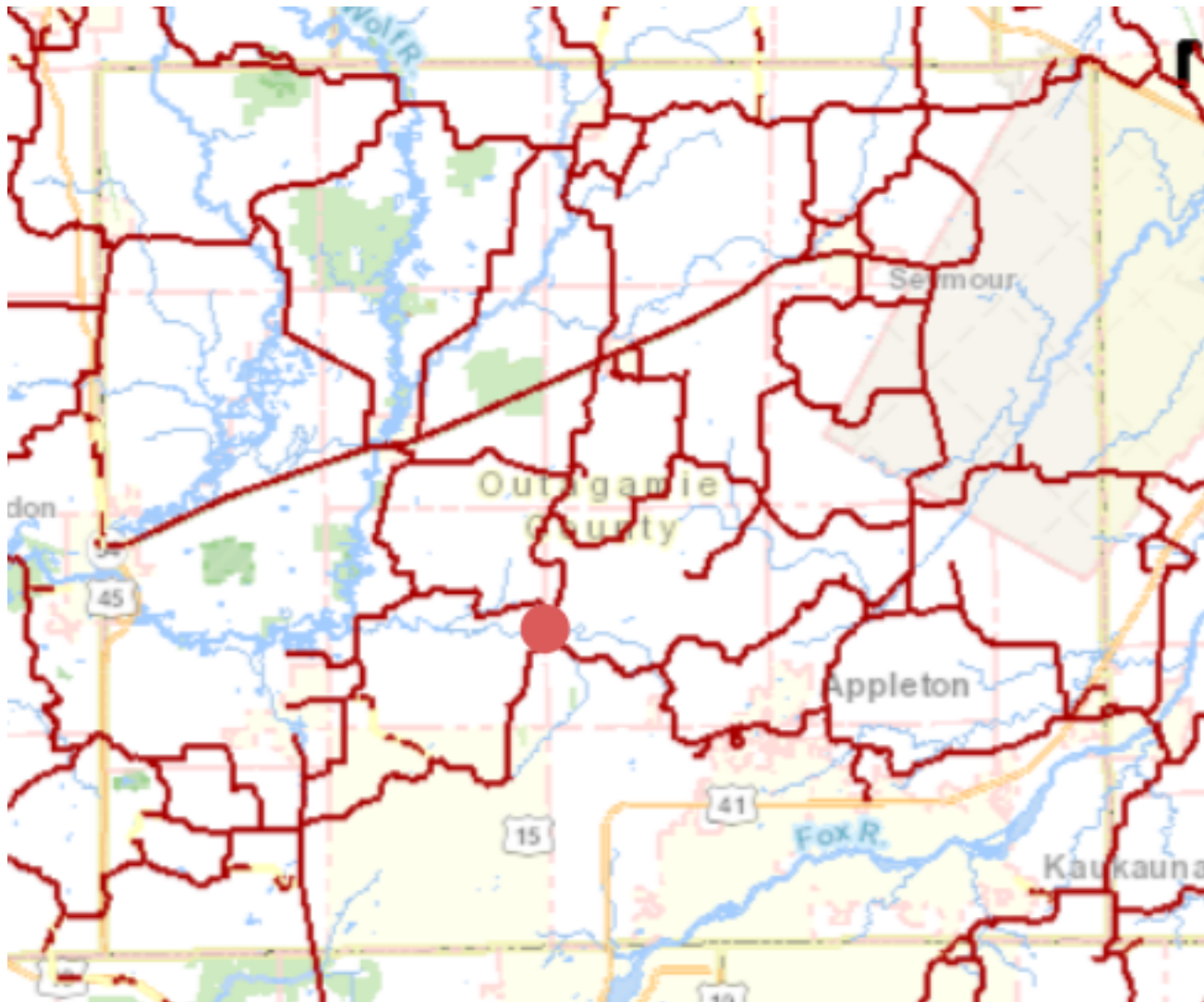
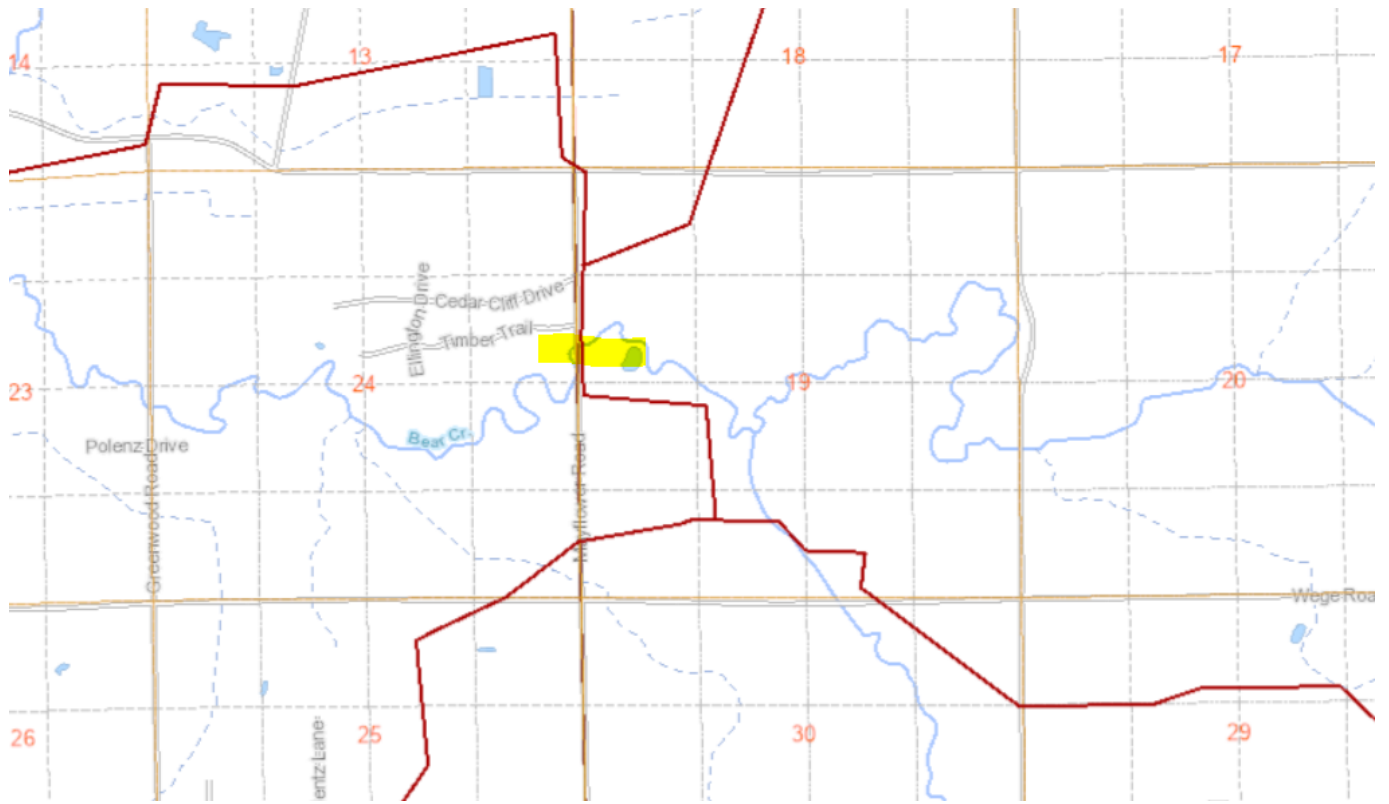

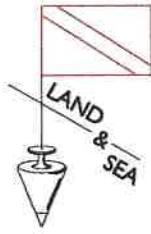

A foundation and structure inspection was performed on March 21, 2024, for a steel beam structure with a wood deck and concrete and stone abutments. The structure is on the property of the Outagamie County Conservation Club and serves as the crossing of Bear Creek on the service road between the two halves of the property. The inspection was conducted by David Pheifer, P.E. of Beyond 24 Leagues, LLC. at the request of Gary Timm, Trail Boss, of the club.

The structure was constructed approximately 30 years ago and consists of two concrete abutments poured on the stone foundation of a previous structure. Superstructure is a 40-foot span with a 12-foot width and span is supported by 2-S24"x 90# beams with an additional S12" x 31# beam that supports the 3x8 timber wood deck. (6) 20' long by 4' wide wood pads have been added to the deck riding surface to reinforce the existing timber decking. Railing is 4 runs of 4x4s with a 6x6 curb, supported on 6 steel posts on 8-foot spacings. Approaches and roadway are gravel aggregate.



VIEW OF ABUTMENT AND UNDERSIDE OF SUPERSTRUCTURE

Abutments are in sound condition.

Railings are solid and will meet requirements for pedestrian hand rail.

Steel superstructure is in excellent condition and has been well maintained.

Loading capacity of structure is 100#/SF snow / Pedestrian load and 25,000 LB. Vehicle load.

Timber deck needs to be replaced. The size of timber decking will determine long term maximum vehicle load.

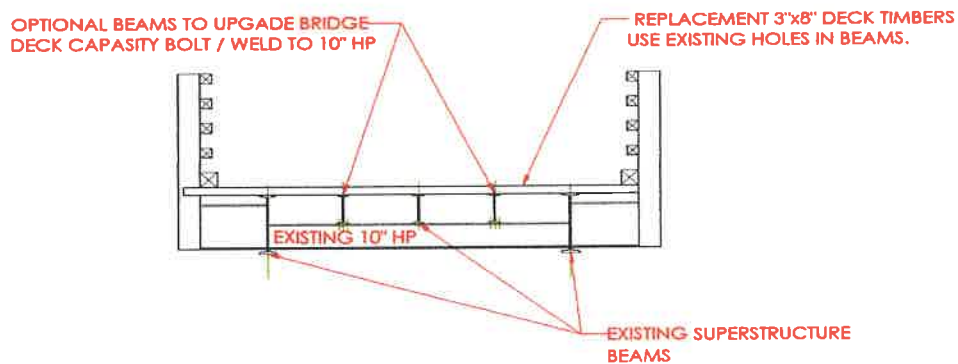
- 3"x8" deck timbers 5000# (F150 pickup)
- 4"x8" deck timbers 7500# (F250 pickup)
- 6"x8" deck timbers 17,000#

Place new deck timbers to match existing bolt spacing in existing beams.

To utilize the full capacity of the structure (25,000#) or to upgrade the lighter plank capacity, there are several options available.

1. Longitudinal running planks could be added.
2. Laminated planking stood on edge could be used.
3. Add a 12" beams between the outside S24 beams and the S12 center beam. This would not be too difficult if done when the existing timber deck is removed during replace.
