

Lincoln County Old Grade Snowmobile Trail Project Description


Lincoln County is requesting maintenance funding for an additional 3.2 miles of snowmobile trail in the Tomahawk area. The new trail will connect two locations with fuel, restrooms, parking, and lodging facilities to currently funded trails. Approximately half of the mileage of the new trail is an old railroad grade owned by the City of Tomahawk. The trail will not require any development funding as it has been maintained as a heavily used club trail for many years. No new bridges or culverts will be necessary. No water crossings are shown on the DNR Surface Water Data Viewer.

Lincoln County will maintain funded trails or assign maintenance activities on funded trails to another representative. Trails will be maintained by grooming, brushing, signing, grading, and performing other approved activities.
