

PFAS & MANGANESE DRINKING WATER GRANT FUNDING OPENS IN JANUARY 2024

\$4 million of federal BIL funding available soon for Other-Than-Municipal Community (OTM) and *Non-profit* Non-Transient Non-Community (NN) public water systems through the Emerging Contaminants in Small or Disadvantaged Communities (EC-SDC) Grant Program

Grant Criteria:

- Must be an OTM or non-profit NN public water system that serves a community with a population less than 10,000.
- Project must address PFAS or manganese contamination.
- Eligible systems must have at least 1 of the following:

□ PFOA or PFOS of 4 ng/L or greater,

 \Box PFAS hazard index (WI DHS or proposed EPA) of 1.0 or greater, or

 \Box Manganese of 300 $\mu g/L$ or greater.

- Maximum award amounts capped at \$240,000 per public water system.
- No cost sharing is required.
- The application period extends from Jan. 16, 2024, to July 31, 2024.

Examples of Eligible Project Components:

- Project planning
- Technical assistance
- Construction or treatment to address contamination including:
 - 1. Consolidation with another water system
 - 2. New well construction and old well abandonment
 - 3. Treatment installation
