George K. Pinney County Park Harbor Dock Replacement & Paystation Upgrade: Burke Pinney, Door County Parks Manager, stated that this request is for the replacement of 4 launch docks and 4 boarding docks that have greatly deteriorated. The new ones will all be ADA compliant. This launch facility is a very heavily used launch facility. It is also a harbor of refuge. This request is also for an upgrade to their current paystation so that annual stickers can also be purchased and dispensed from this paystation. Roger Walsh asked when the current docks were originally installed. Burke stated that they were installed in 2006, so they got about 15 full seasons of use. Jan Allman asked about the condition of the breakwater. Burke stated that they have a County Conservation Aids grant to do some repairs to the breakwater structure. Korin Doering asked about the difference in structure material between the old and the new docks. Burke stated that the old ones were wooden underneath with plastic on top and the new ones will be made of recycled plastic, wood, and steel. Bruce Neeb asked about the payment options on the paystation. Burke stated that all the current pay options will remain the same and that includes using cash.
