WAMS replaced by MyWisconsin ID

On June 13, 2025, the Web Access Management Systems (WAMS) login platform used to access the Environmental Loans Online Systems switched to a new login system called MyWisconsin ID.

What does this mean for me?

Self-register for a MyWisconsin ID account

After the migration has been completed, you will not be able to access the Environmental Loans Online Systems until you create a MyWisconsin ID account. Any users who have a WAMS account will be required to set up a new login, password and multi-factor authentication (MFA) preferences through MyWisconsin ID to prepare for the transition. For guidance, see "[What do I need to do?](#)" below.

- If you already created a MyWisconsin ID for another DNR system or State agency (e.g. Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection), *you do **not** need to create another.*
- **Registration is time sensitive.** Once the base information is entered, registration must be completed within 2 hours (including MFA setup). Accounts that are not completely set up are automatically deleted every 2 hours. If you were unable to complete all registration steps (verify email, create password, enroll in at least one MFA method) in one sitting, please wait 2 hours and then start the registration process over.

No shared accounts

If you share a WAMS ID that you did not create, you will need a new MyWisconsin ID to log in to the Environmental Loans Online Systems. Do not link your new MyWisconsin ID to any previous WAMS ID that you did not create. Once your MyWisconsin ID and MFA preferences are set up, follow the "[For new users](#)" instructions below to request access to systems. A specific MyWisconsin ID is for an individual person, not a facility or company and should NEVER be used by others. Because MFA is used, the MyWisconsin ID account **cannot be shared** with others – all users must have their own account.

- **Multi-factor authentication (MFA)** is an electronic security process that requires users to provide at least two factors of information during the login procedure to gain access to an account. For example, after entering your password, you must also enter a one-time verification code you receive via text message.

What is MyWisconsin ID?

MyWisconsin ID, provided by the Department of Administration (DOA) allows users the ability to securely access various participating online state services and systems using a single user ID and password. The current login systems (WAMS and Wisconsin Logon Management System [WILMS]) were built with old technology and will no longer be available after December 2026. MyWisconsin ID uses modern authentication, which provides better functionality and security improvements, including fighting against identity theft. Note: The timeline in this publication applies only to the Environmental Loans Online Systems, which are used to apply for Clean Water Fund Program (CWFP) and Safe Drinking Water Loan Program (SDWLP) financial assistance. State agencies and programs are migrating to MyWisconsin ID at different times between now and December 2026. *In the meantime, a WAMS ID may be needed for some systems, while a MyWisconsin ID will be needed for others.*

What Do I Need To Do?

Self-register for a MyWisconsin ID account

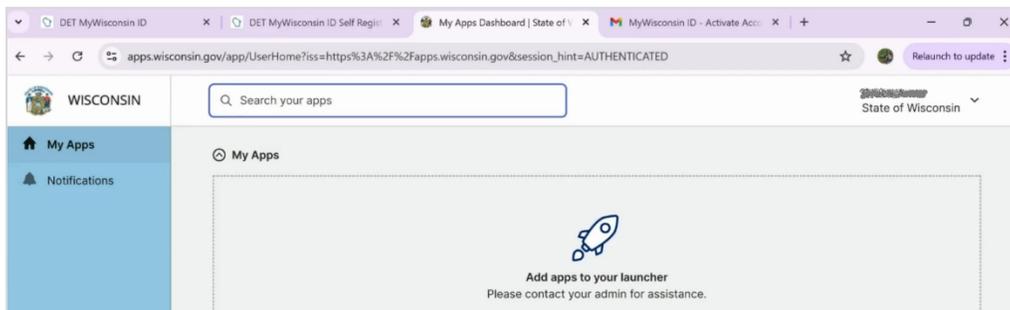
If you currently have a WAMS account, you must self-register for a MyWisconsin ID by following the step-by-step guide on the DOA's [MyWisconsin ID Self Registration webpage](#). You can also watch the [How to Create a MyWisconsin ID video tutorial](#).

Step 8 is the last step in the DOA's guide. After setting up at least one MFA method for your account, you will be directed to the last screen to set up additional MFA methods *if desired*.

- Scroll to the bottom of the security methods list and click "Continue" to complete your registration.



After you click "Continue", you will be signed in to your new MyWisconsin ID account and see a screen like the one shown below. *You do not need to do anything when you get to this screen – simply exit this page.*



What happens next?

Once your MyWisconsin ID and MFA preferences are set up:

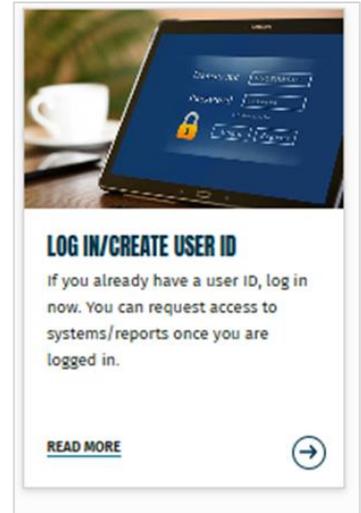
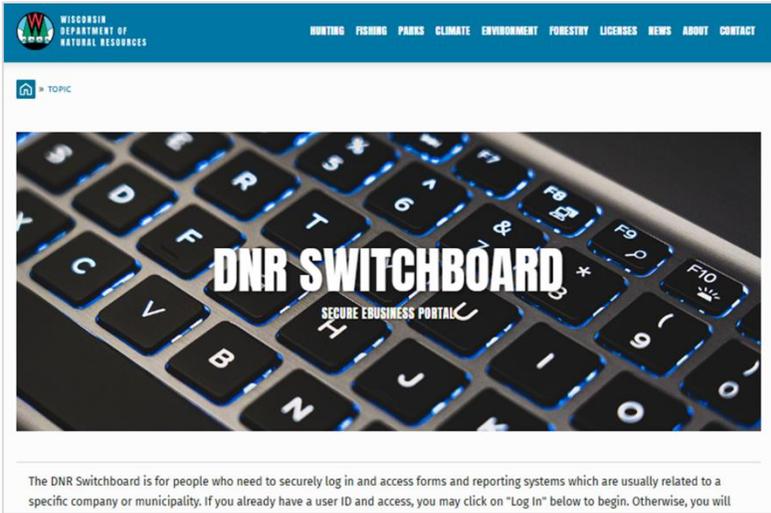
- After the migration is complete, you will use the MyWisconsin ID option to access the Environmental Loans Online Systems. Note that the WAMS option will be removed later in 2025.
- **The first time you log in** using your new MyWisconsin ID, you will be prompted to transfer your WAMS data (permissions, "Financial: CWFP/SDWLP Loans – ITA/PERF and Application Systems" access roles) to your new MyWisconsin ID account. For guidance, see "[Linking WAMS Data to MyWisconsin ID](#)" below. If you skip the transfer step, you will likely have to "re-request" new access to the Environmental Loans Online Systems via the DNR Switchboard.

How will I know it's time to use MyWisconsin ID?

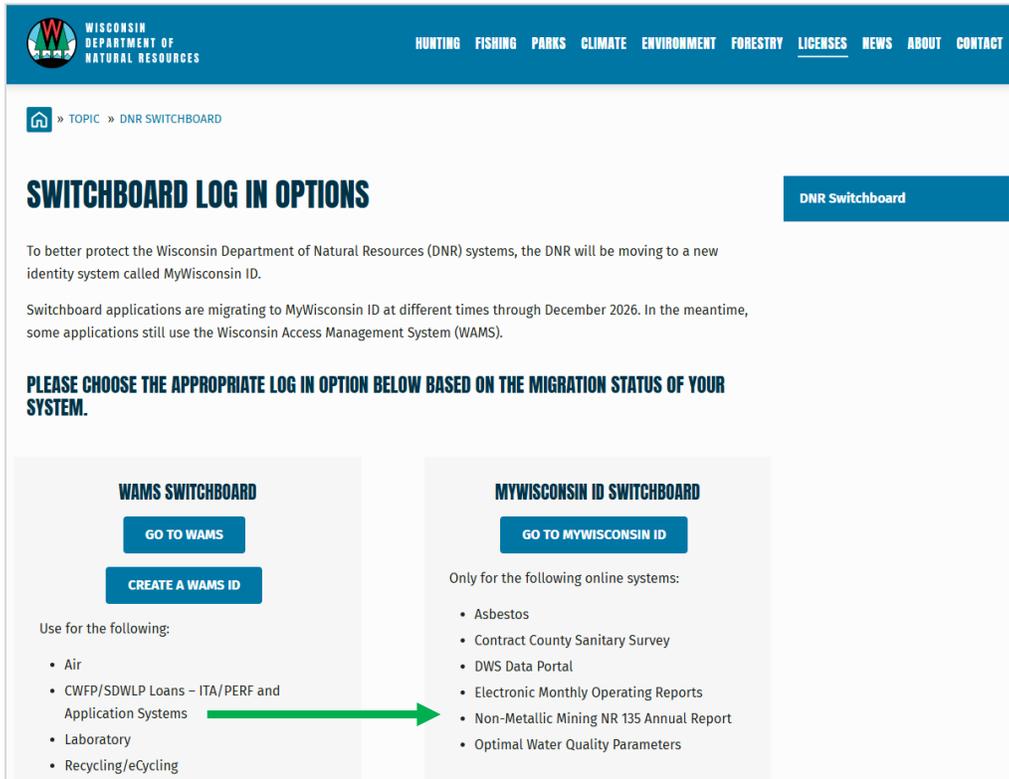
After we completed the move to MyWisconsin ID for the Environmental Loans Online Systems, the DNR Environmental Loans Section notified you through a GovDelivery email (which we also posted to our [News webpage](#)), an email from our [Section staff](#) or both. You can also check the status of the log in platform transition yourself through the DNR Switchboard.

Self-verification instructions for DNR Switchboard

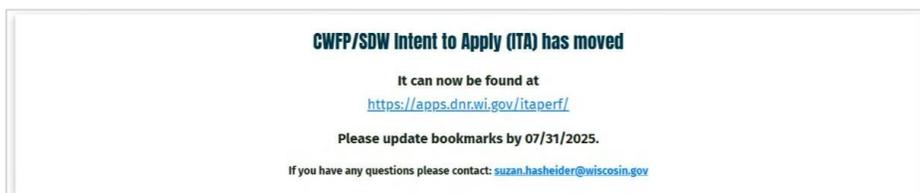
Most users are familiar with the DNR Switchboard webpage shown below. Clicking "Log In/Create User ID" on this webpage will take you to the Switchboard Log In Options webpage (pictured below).



Users will know that it is time to use their new MyWisconsin ID when the "CWFP/SDWLP Loans – ITA/PERF and Application Systems" bullet point moves from the "WAMS Switchboard" box on the left to the "MyWisconsin ID Switchboard" box on the right, see image below.



Note: If users have their WAMS account saved as a bookmark, they will see a redirect link, like the one shown below, that will take them to the Switchboard Log In Options webpage (shown above).

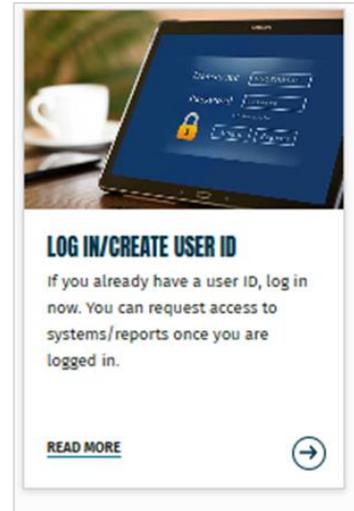
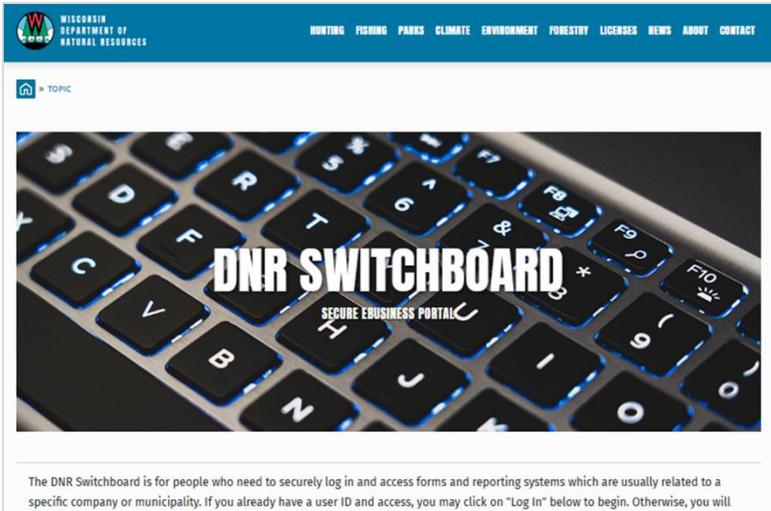


Linking WAMS Data to MyWisconsin ID

The first time you log in using your new MyWisconsin ID, you should transfer your previous WAMS data (permissions, "Financial: CWF/SDWLP Loans – ITA/PERF and Application Systems" access roles) to your new MyWisconsin ID account. If you skip the transfer step, you will likely have to "re-request" new access to the Environmental Loans Online Systems via the DNR Switchboard.

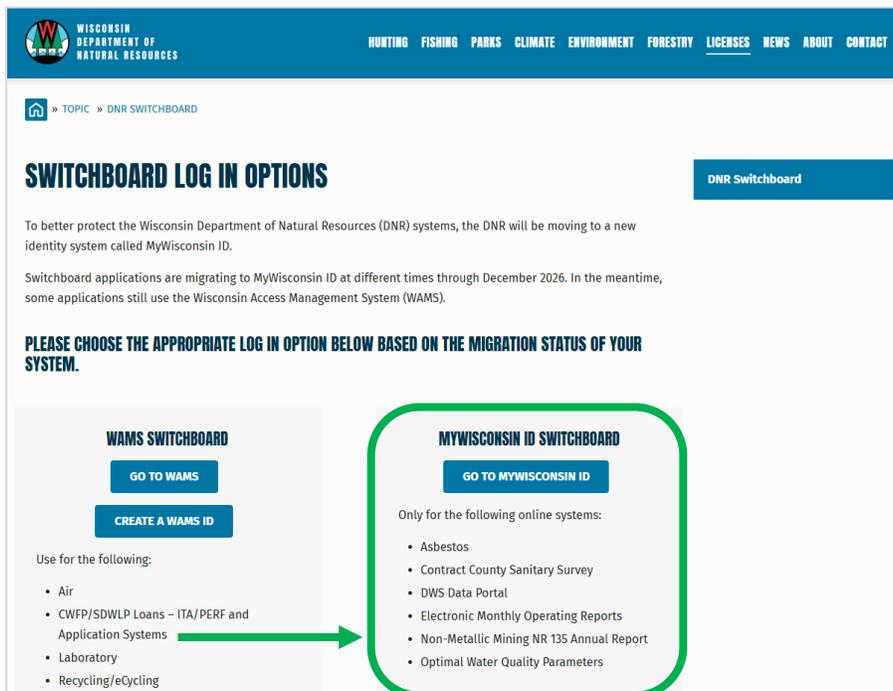
1. DNR Switchboard webpage (shown below).

- a. Clicking "Log In/Create User ID" on the DNR Switchboard webpage will take you to the Switchboard Log In Options webpage.



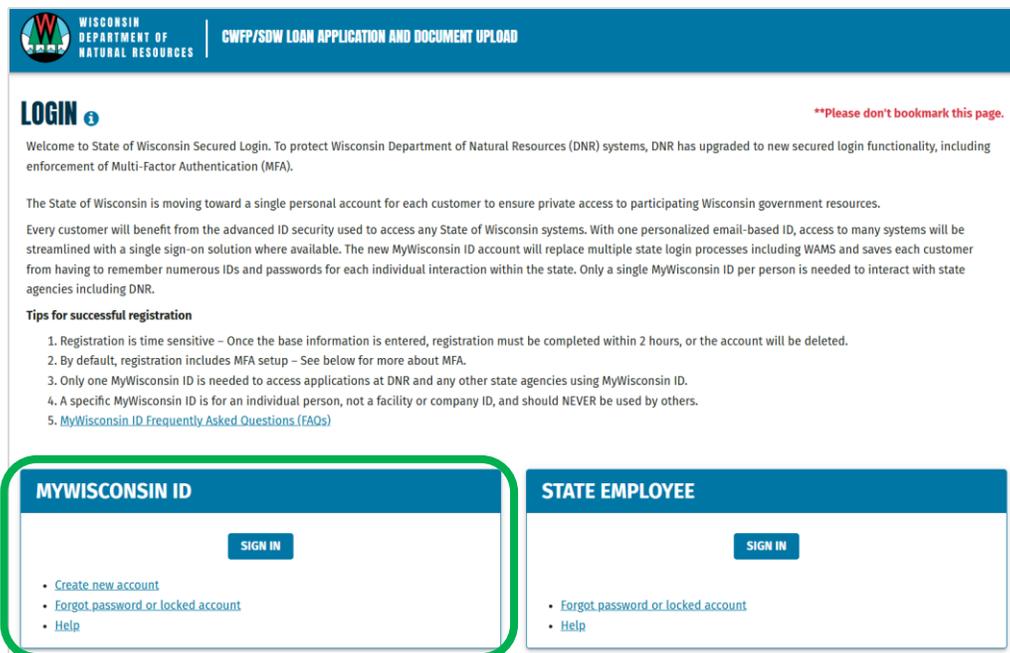
2. Switchboard Log In Options webpage (shown below).

- a. Choose the MyWisconsin ID Switchboard option by clicking "Go to MyWisconsin ID" on the Switchboard Log In Options webpage.



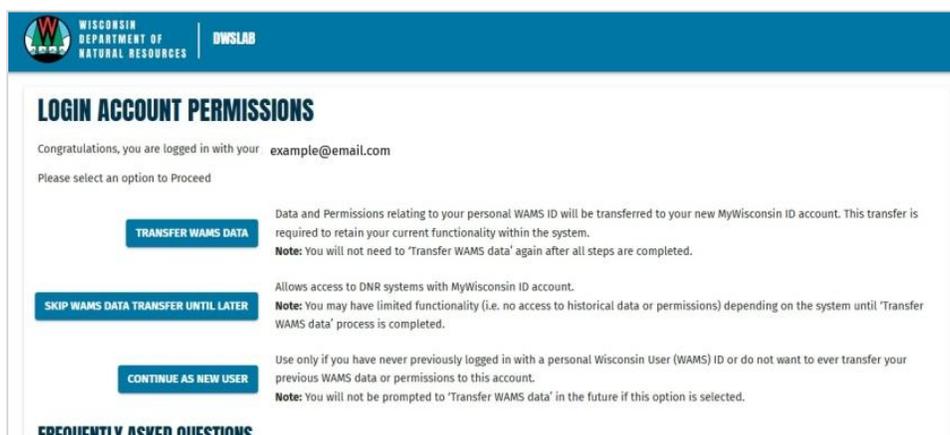
3. **Login webpage** (shown below).

- a. Note: The title of the Login webpage should be either "CWFP/SDW Intent to Apply (ITA)" or "CWFP/SDW Loan Application and Document Upload." Except for the title, these Login webpages are identical to one another. *Please do not bookmark either of these pages.*
- b. Under MyWisconsin ID, click "Sign In."
- c. You will be prompted to verify your identity with the email, password, and multi-factor authentication (MFA) method you selected during the MyWisconsin ID self-registration process. Note: You may be prompted to continue selecting certain images on the screen until the system determines that you have proven you are not a robot.



4. **Login Account Permissions webpage** (shown below).

- a. **The first time you log in** using your new MyWisconsin ID, you should transfer your previous WAMS data (permissions, "Financial" access roles) to your new MyWisconsin ID account. Read the transfer option descriptions on the webpage to make an informed choice. If you skip the transfer step, you will likely have to "re-request" new access to the Environmental Loans Online Systems via the DNR Switchboard.



- i. **For existing users:** Click "**Transfer WAMS Data.**" You will be prompted to enter your old WAMS ID username and password. Click "Submit".

- ii. **For new users:** Users without previous WAMS data can click "Continue As New User."
 1. New users will need permission to access systems and reports, see the [DNR Switchboard Instructions, FAQs and Troubleshooting webpage](#). Choose the "Financial" access role for the Environmental Loans Online Systems. To find the correct municipality, you can enter either the Facility ID (FID) number, WPDES permit number, Public Water Supply number, or Department of Revenue (DOR) municipal code. The DOR municipal codes can be found in the *second* column of this [spreadsheet](#).

Additional Notes

After the Environmental Loans Online Systems transferred to MyWisconsin ID, the access links to the online loan systems changed. These links have been updated on the [Online Systems webpage](#).

After the transition from WAMS to MyWisconsin ID, you should notice an appearance change on the login screen, as shown below.
