

# **Air Emissions Inventory (EI) – Revising Historical Air Emissions Inventory (EI) Data**

# General

- When the EI data year is archived by DNR in December, the data become historical.
- Edits of historical EI data are very limited.
- Only process-level controlled emissions can be edited in historical data.
- Edits to historical data will not impact EI summary reports.
- Edits to historical data impact:
  - The [10-year trend reports](#) generated using the most recent ten years of historical EIs after the EI data year is archived in December.
  - Data requests fulfilled from revision date forward.

# Revising EI historical data

1. For a process-level controlled emissions revision to be implemented, two conditions must be satisfied:
  - a. The total facility level emissions for the pollutant must exceed the pollutant's reporting threshold before or after the change is made.
  - b. The change in emissions must exceed 2% of the pollutant's reporting threshold.

# Revising EI historical data

2. To revise EI historical data, email the facility ID, facility name, device ID, process ID, pollutant and new process-level controlled emissions to either the facility-assigned compliance engineer or [DNRAMEmissionsInventory@wisconsin.gov](mailto:DNRAMEmissionsInventory@wisconsin.gov).
