Background

The DNR developed the proposed SIP revision to request that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) redesignate the Door County-Revised, WI, 2015 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) nonattainment area to attainment. The Door County-Revised nonattainment area consists of the area in Door County north of the Sturgeon Bay Canal excluding Newport State Park. Based on air quality monitoring data for the years 2019-2021, the Door County-Revised nonattainment area has demonstrated attainment of the 2015 ozone NAAQS. This proposed SIP submittal demonstrates that all applicable provisions of the Clean Air Act regarding redesignation to attainment have been met for the Door County-Revised nonattainment area.

Action Subject to Comment

The DNR is soliciting comment on this proposed SIP submittal.

Comments on this proposed SIP submittal should be received on or before January 4, 2022. Written comments may be submitted by U.S. mail or email and will have the same weight and effect as verbal statements presented at the public hearing.
