Background

This SIP revision has been developed by the DNR to demonstrate attainment of the 2010 1-hour Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂) National Ambient Air Quality Standard for the partial Oneida County nonattainment area. Specifically, the proposed SIP revision contains updated permanent and enforceable emission limitations for the Ahlstrom-Munksjo paper mill located in Rhinelander, Wisconsin, the primary source of SO₂ emissions in the nonattainment area. These limits are made permanent and federally enforceable by inclusion in Air Pollution Control Construction Permit Revision 15-DMM-128-R1, as well as this attainment plan. When considered with the SIP submittals previously provided by DNR to EPA in 2016, this SIP revision fulfills the requirements of the Clean Air Act to demonstrate attainment of the 2010 SO₂ standard in the partial Oneida County nonattainment area.

Action Subject to Comment

The DNR is soliciting comment on this proposed SIP submittal.
