Background

The Chicago-Naperville, IL-IN-WI, nonattainment area for the 2008 ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) consists of all or portions of 11 counties in Illinois, Indiana and Wisconsin. This area includes 8 counties in Illinois (including two partial counties), two counties in Indiana, and the eastern part of Kenosha County in Wisconsin. On August 23, 2019, EPA reclassified the Chicago nonattainment area to serious nonattainment status, effective September 23, 2019 (84 FR 44238). Due to this action, Wisconsin is required to submit a plan to EPA demonstrating how the partial Kenosha County nonattainment area will attain the 2008 ozone NAAQS by the serious area attainment date of July 20, 2021. DNR is proposing to submit this SIP to fulfill that requirement.

Action Subject to Comment

The DNR is soliciting comment on this proposed SIP submittal.

Agency Contact and Submitting Comment

Comments on this proposed SIP submittal should be received no later than November 9, 2020. Written comments may be submitted by U.S. mail, fax, or email and will have the same weight and effect as oral statements presented at the public hearing.
