The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) will hold a public informational meeting to review Wisconsin's ambient air quality monitoring network.

On May 10, 2024, the Air Management program made available for public review and comment the federally required "Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources 2025 Air Monitoring Network Plan." Wisconsin is required to submit an annual network plan to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) that shows the siting and operation of each monitor meets the requirements of 40 CFR Part 58. The plan proposes DNR recommended changes to the ambient monitoring network based on monitor history, population distribution and modifications to federal monitoring requirements. Responses to the plan are gathered through public comments, a public meeting and EPA response. This plan certifies that the state has met all federal ambient air monitoring requirements.
