Superfund Task Force Final Report

The Superfund Task Force published its final report (September 9) on the recommendations developed in response to the EPA Administrator's request on May 22, 2017. The recommendations address: expediting cleanup and remediation process; reducing financial burden on all parties involved in the entire cleanup process; encouraging private investment; promoting redevelopment and community revitalization; and building and strengthening partnerships.
