

- 2. State Funded: Vapor Intrusion Zone Contract (VIZC) vapor investigation at open sites; mitigation where needed
- 3. Responsible Party (RP) Funded: open site with redevelopment
- 4. RP Funded: open site without redevelopment
- 5. RP Funded: open site with high public health risk
