
Statutes and Administrative Code

The Examining Board of Professional Geologists, Hydrologists and Soil Scientists is created in Wis. Stat. § 15.405(2m) and has authority as outlined in Wis. Stat. ch. 470. The Board convenes to address matters of joint interest and is divided into 3 Sections to address matters specific to its respective professional areas.

### **Members**

The members of the Examining Board of Professional Geologists, Hydrologists and Soil Scientists are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Legislature to serve 4-year terms. The Board consists of 12 members: 3 professional geologists, 3 professional hydrologists, 3 professional soil scientists and 3 public members.

### **Updates - Administrative Code Revisions**



### What's New? Starting August 2026

Professional Geologists (P.G.s) – 24 contact hours per biennium

Professional Hydrologists (P.H.s) – 4 contact hours per biennium

Current licensed professionals will be required to complete the contact hours before the **August 2028** biennium renewal.

Although continuing education contact hours will be required for the August 2028 renewal, new applicants/licenses are not required until their first full biennium renewal is due.

2. Detailed description of the objective of the proposed rule:


The objective of the proposed rule is to bring the GHSS administrative code into compliance with 2013 Act 114, which prohibits credentialing boards from requiring a person to complete postsecondary education before the person is eligible to take an examination for a credential.

3. Description of the existing policies relevant to the rule, new policies proposed to be included in the rule, and an analysis of policy alternatives:

2013 Act 114 prohibits credentialing boards from requiring a person to complete postsecondary education before the person is eligible to take an examination for a credential. The proposed rule will revise the GHSS administrative code to bring it into compliance with the Act.

The proposed rule will update and clarify the examination requirements including the removal of outdated and obsolete provisions.

If this rule is not pursued, the GHSS administrative code will remain out of compliance with the new legislation and may continue to have obsolete or confusing provisions relating to exams.

This proposal and recommendations were developed by the Remediation and Redevelopment External Advisory Group and members of the public, and do not necessarily represent the opinions or the position of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources or other state agencies.

### TYPE OF RECOMMENDATION - LEGISLATIVE

This issue paper is to document the business need for mitigation contractor certification in Wisconsin and related issues for consideration. A mitigation certification program is being considered to address issues with contractor qualifications and accountability identified in Wisconsin with both radon and vapor intrusion mitigation systems. The National Radon Proficiency Program (NRPP), which is administered by the Indoor Environments Association (IEA), also known as AARST, is working to develop and finalize credentials for vapor intrusion mitigation on a national level. The goal of mitigation contractor certification is to ensure soil gas mitigation systems, designed and installed by qualified personnel according to established industry consensus standards, are protective of the health of occupants and limit potentially harmful exposures.

Recommendations by the DNR's Remediation and Redevelopment External Advisory Group (RR EAG) will not be developed until the NRPP vapor intrusion mitigation credential program has been finalized and subsequently reviewed by Wisconsin stakeholders. Information memorialized in this issue paper will be further considered at that time.


