- * If not sediment Manage based on type of waste
- * Some may meet "Clean Fill" criteria
- * Some may require landfill disposal

- * Dredged sediment is solid waste
- * May be
 - * clean
 - * mildly contaminated or
 - * significantly contaminated

- Managed by facility guidelines

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- * Manage according to
 - * NR 500
 - *NR 600
 - * TSCA (40 CFR 761)

- * If sediment dredged for NR 700 response action
- * Manage per NR 718.15 = Other Solid Waste
- * Can be placed on upland source site

- * If sediment dredged for NR 700 response action
- *Can also be managed with Low Hazard Exemption on another property Stats. 289.43(8)

- * NR 720 standards can be used for decisions on acceptable options for upland non landfill management
- * Direct Contact and Groundwater Protective RCLs
