Applicable Act 204 Definitions

Contaminated Sediment:

Sediment that contains a hazardous substance

Sediment:

Particles in the bed of a navigable water <u>up to the ordinary high water</u> <u>mark</u> that are derived from the erosion of rock, minerals, soil, and biological materials and from chemical precipitation from the water column and that are transported or deposited by water

Sediment vs. Soil w/ Respect to the OHWM

WATER's EDGE

(Annual/Seasonal High)
Use CBSQG

or

Pursue site-specific number(s)

TRANSITION AREA

(Between Water's Edge and OHWM)
Use the more protective of CBSQG or NR720

<u>or</u>

Pursue site-specific number(s)

Ordinary High Water Mark

UPLAND - SOIL

(Above OHWM)

Use NR 720 unless NR 716.07(8)(a), (b) and/or (c) apply Site-specific number(s) may be necessary for sites that meet NR 716.07(8) criteria.

- (c) Outstanding resource waters and exceptional resource waters as defined in ss. NR 102.10 and 102.11
