Receiving Waters: Surface waters and land application sites in Wisconsin

Brief Description of Operations Covered under this General Permit: The permit covers the handling and land application of manure and process wastewater at new, existing or expanding dairy animal feeding operations with at least 1,000 animal units but no more than 5720 animal units. This is a first time issuance for this general permit.

Following the public notice period and public informational hearings held on March 26, 2010 (Wausau), April 1, 2010, (Grand Chute), April 6, 2010 (Viroqua), April 8, 2010 (Eau Claire), and April 13, 2010 (Fitchburg) the Department of Natural Resources ("the Department") has made a final determination to issue the Large Dairy CAFO General WPDES Permit. The information from the WPDES permit file, comments received on the proposed permit and applicable administrative codes were used as a basis for this final determination. The Department has the authority to issue, modify, suspend, or revoke WPDES permits and to establish effluent limitations and permit conditions under ch. 283, Stats. The Department's findings of fact and conclusions of law are included in this Notice of Final Determination, the "Permit Changes and Response to Comments" document (which is included by reference and available at http://dnr.wi.gov/runoff/ag/permits.htm, click on the "General Permits" tab) and the WPDES permit. In the issuance of the final permit, the Department has considered the information in the Environmental Assessment and the comments received on it. The Department has complied with the requirements of ch. NR 150 and s. 1.11, Stats. Within the authority under Wis. Stat. ch. 283 and ch. NR 243, Wis. Adm. Code, the Department has included conditions in the WPDES permit to minimize impacts to water resources of the state.

As provided by s. 283.63, Stats., and ch. 203, Wis. Adm. Code, persons desiring further adjudicative review of this final determination may request a public adjudicatory hearing. A request shall be made by filing a verified petition for review with the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources within 60 days of the date the permit was signed (see permit signature date above). Further information regarding the conduct and nature of public adjudicatory hearings may be obtained by contacting the Department of Natural Resources and by review of ch. NR 203, Wis. Adm. Code, s. 283.63 Stats., and applicable code law.
