### **Sky Codes:**

- 0 = clear or a few clouds
- 1 = partly cloudy (scattered) or variable sky
- 2 = cloudy (broken) or overcast
- $4 = \log \text{ or smoke}$
- **5** = drizzle or light rain
- **6** = showers
- **7** = snow

## **Land Ownership Types:**

- 1 = private
- 2 = federal (NPS, USFWS)
- **3** = state (DNR, DOT)
- **4** = county (Grant County)
- **5** = municipal (Town of Mineral Point)
- **6** = tribal (Bad River Tribe)
- **7** = NGO (The Nature Conservancy)
- 8 = other

#### **Beaufort Wind Codes:**

- **0** = calm; smoke rises vertically (<1 mph)
- 1 = light air; smoke drifts, weather vain inactive (1-3 mph)
- 2 = light breeze; leaves rustle, can feel wind on face (4-7 mph)
- **3** = gentle breeze; leaves and small twigs in constant motion, wind extends light flag (8-12 mph)
- **4** = moderate breeze; small branches move, raises dust and loose paper (13-18 mph)
