
Introduction

Spillerberg Lake is a 75-acre lake with stained water and a maximum depth of 24 feet. In 2022, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) conducted a fall electrofishing survey to assess gamefish recruitment.

WALLEYE



During the fall electrofishing survey, crews captured a total of 140 walleyes at a high rate of 94.6 per mile. Walleyes ranged in length from 6.1 - 19.0 inches and averaged 10.4 inches. 35 age-0 (young-of-year) walleyes were sampled at a moderate rate of 23.3 per mile, and 69 age-1 walleyes were sampled at a high rate of 46.0 per mile. These results suggest that ample natural reproduction is occurring to support this selfsustaining population.



OTHER SPECIES

During the fall recruitment survey, crews also sampled one juvenile muskellunge.
