





2013 Fox River Tagged Walleye Angler Recapture Locations

Green Bay Surveys for Yellow Perch


- Creel (Open Water & Ice)
- Spring fyke netting (Little Tail)
- Shoreline seining (15 sites)
- Trawling YOY surveys (76 ¼ mile drags)
- Commercial monitoring (9 samples between May 20-Nov.)






YOY Yellow Perch from summer trawling surveys






Green Bay Whitefish Fishery

- Considerable changes in WF pop over the past 15-20 years
- Re-colonization of tributaries
 - And Green Bay proper?
- Strong recruitment events
 - 2015 strongest to date
- Changing fisheries
 - Increased commercial catches
 - Substantial recreational fishery
- Increased stock complexity




Green Bay Whitefish Sport Harvest









Tributary/Green Bay Spawning Whitefish

- Menominee sampled annually since 2009
 - Fox, Oconto, and Peshtigo since 2013

Tagging

- ~2800 tagged in Menominee, Fox, Peshtigo,
 Oconto in 2015/2016
- Examine for straying between rivers, Green Bay, and Lake Michigan
- Angler tag reports important

Green Bay spawning

- Information suggests spawning in Green Bay proper
- Have found larval whitefish in Sturgeon Bay last two years
- Found eggs (likely lake whitefish) in Sturgeon Bay
 November 2016

ATTENTION ANGLERS

Please be on the Lookout for Tagged Whitefish in Green Bay

During November, 2015, approximately 1,300 lake whitefish were tagged and released in the Menominee, Fox, Peshtigo and Oconto Rivers. Information gathered from tag returns will help us to collect several pieces of important information for management of these populations of whitefish. Tagged fish will have either one or two tags placed at the base of the dorsal fin (see photo below):








Size Distribution Between Tributaries


- Fox River tend to be somewhat larger
- Cardy's Reef =
 North/Moonlight Bay stock (Lake MI)
 - Limited recruitment in recent years
- Sport harvest size similar to river spawning fish



Whitefish Research 2017

- Acoustic telemetry (UWSP)
 - Approx. 300 fish to be tagged
 - Receivers deployed strategic locations
 - Acoustic tags 3 year capacity
 - Fish will have loop tags for external id

- Otolith microchemistry (UWGB)
 - Identification of populations based on chemical signature of ear bone
 - Origin: Rivers, Green Bay, Lake Michigan





Green Bay Ice Guide Reporting

- Goal: Increase accuracy of harvest estimates
- Supplement bio-data (e.g. tags)
- Guided trip data often difficult to capture
 - Greater success rate than average angler
- Strong overall support for reporting
- Pilot data in 2016 provided some insight on scale of whitefish harvest and effort
- Positive reflection of the Green Bay guiding community

The following instructions are designed to assist the licensee in preparing this monthly report of guided ice fishing activities on Green Bay:

GUIDE LICENSEE'S NAME: Print your name as it appears on your guide license.

DNR CUSTOMER NUMBER: Enter your DNR Customer # which can be found on your guide license.

MONTH: Enter the number of the month for which the report is being prepared.

YEAR: Enter the year in which the report is being prepared.

DATE: Enter the date number of the day on which the fishing occurred. Record each fishing party as a separate

entry (i.e. you guide two separate parties on the same date, enter the date twice with a separate line for

each fishing party).

NUMBER OF ANGLERS: Enter the total number of anglers in the fishing party guided on this day.

HOURS FISHED: Enter the number of hours that your party fished, rounded to the nearest ½ hour, in which the fishing party

was engaged in fishing (i.e. if the trip was 8 hours long for a particular party, enter 8 hours fished). Enter

each party on a separate line.

FISH DATA (WHITEFISH, WALLEYE, YELLOW PERCH, OTHER SPECIES - excluding rough fish)

KEPT: Enter the total number <u>caught and kept</u> by anglers in the fishing party on the day.

RELEASED: Enter the total number <u>caught and released</u> by the anglers in the fishing party on the day.

TAG NUMBERS/OTHER Enter any fish tag numbers from any fish caught and any other information which you feel may be of

OBSERVATIONS: value to the department in managing the fishery resource.

SIGN, DATE and SUBMIT your completed Fishing Guide Report on or before the 10th day of each month on the records for the preceding calendar month to the following address:

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Summary

- Reporting begins Jan 1, 2017
 - Forms will be required during ice season defined as December thru March beginning above start date
 - If not fishing, forms still required for those months
 - E.g. "Did not fish"
 - Potential for expansion to reporting for open water months, but not at this time
- Reports due 10th day of month for preceding month
- Daily record-keeping notebooks are available upon request (see sample notebook)
