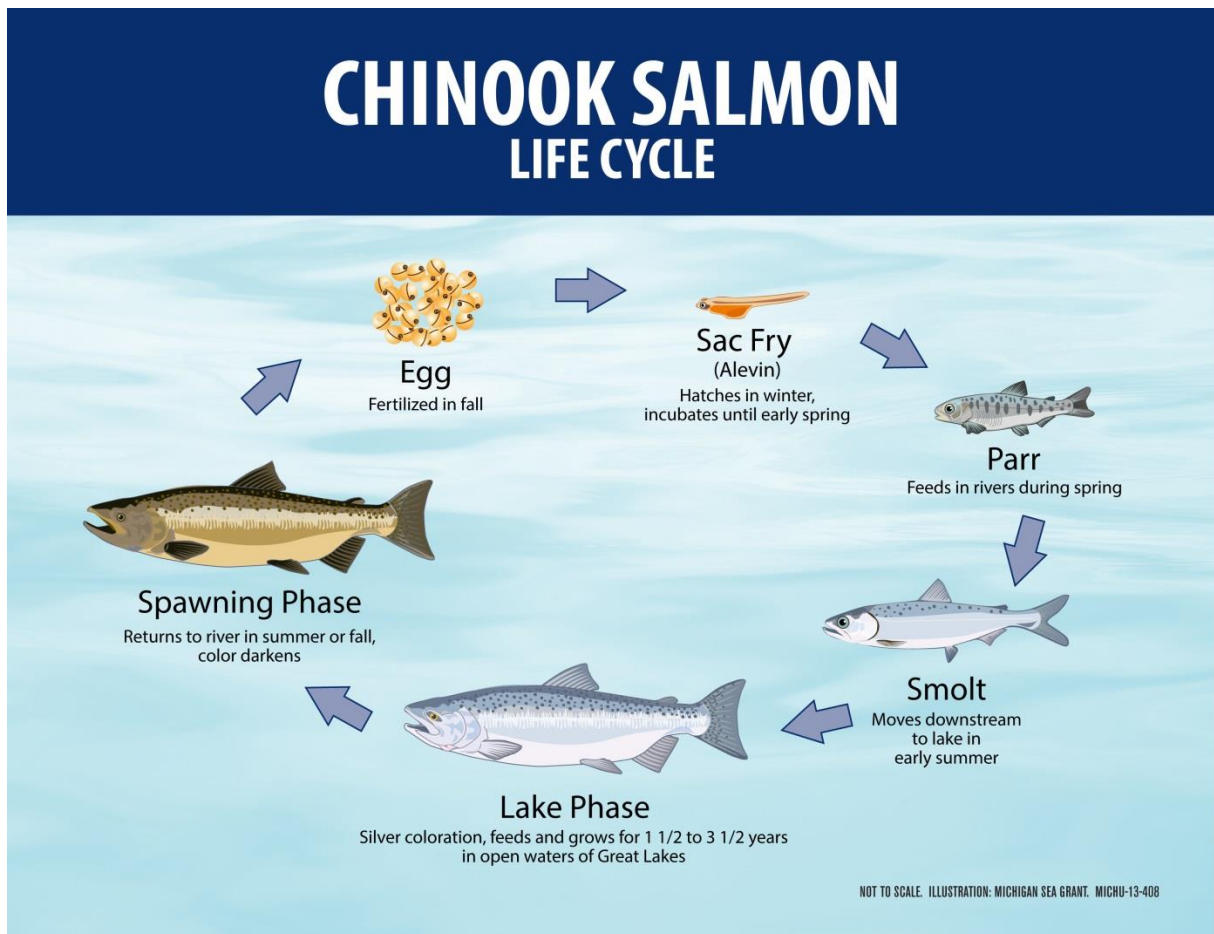

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Wisconsin's Lake Michigan Salmonid Stocking Summary

This stocking summary is based on stocking records entered by Wisconsin DNR staff into the statewide propagation database each time hatchery fish were stocked into Lake Michigan, with Lake trout data provided by US Fish and Wildlife Service.

There are four types of information included in this summary report. First, total number of trout and salmon stocked from 1963-2024 are summarized (pages 3-4) and is intended to provide an overview of long-term trends in the stocking of each species.

The next two summaries account for fish stocked during 2020-2024. Detailed stocking information for 2020-2024 is provided since this year's harvest of all species, except lake trout, will be based primarily on fish stocked in those years. The second summary (pages 5-9) focuses on the numbers of fish stocked in each county along the Lake Michigan shoreline in 2020-2024. The third summary (pages 11-25) is a set of tables detailing specific stocking sites, the specific number and age of fish planted at each site and any identifying fin clips or marks. A map of the Lake Michigan shoreline (Figure 1, page 9) is included to assist with locating stocking sites.

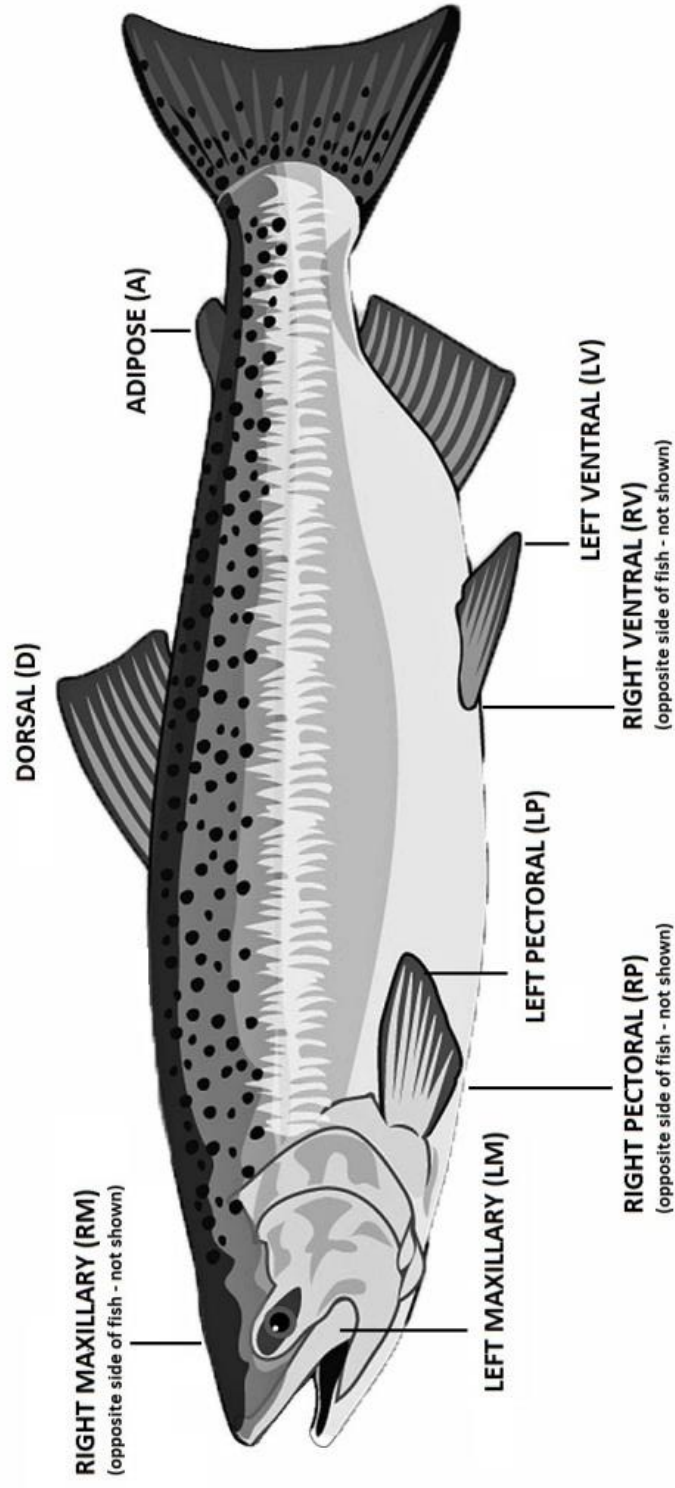


Figure 2. Fin clip diagram.

The fourth summary (pages 27-29) focuses on stocked salmon and trout that were clipped, with year ranges based on average life span of each species on Lake Michigan. The ages of fish at time of stocking are indicated as fingerling (F), yearling (Y) or adult (A). Fish may be clipped on one or more of the following body parts: adipose (A), dorsal (D), right or left maxillary (RM/LM), right or left pectoral fins (RP/LP), right or left ventral fins (RV/LV) or both pectoral/ventral fins (BP/BV). A diagram of a Chinook salmon depicting fin and maxillary locations is included with the summary (Figure 2, page 27).

The "CWT" used in the summaries stands for coded wire tag, referring to fish that have a small wire tag inserted into their snouts at the hatchery. These tags have a number etched into them which is associated with the year the fish was stocked, the organization that stocked the fish, where the fish was stocked, etc. All rainbow trout stocked 2018-2024 (excluding 2021), all lake trout stocked since 2011, and all Chinook stocked 2011-2016 in Wisconsin waters of Lake Michigan were marked with an adipose clip and implanted with a CWT as part of a lakewide effort to determine the rates of natural reproduction in Lake Michigan.

The Lake Michigan salmonids summarized here presently include fish stocked from varied genetic strains. Brook trout are St. Croix (SC) strain. Brown trout are Seeforellen (S) strain. Strains for both coho and Chinook are Lake Michigan (M). Lake trout strains include Apostle Islands (SAI), Klondike Reef (SKL), Lewis Lake (MLL), Parry Sound (HPS) and Seneca Lake (SEN). Rainbow trout strains include Arlee (A), Chambers Creek (C), Ganaraska (G), Little Manistee River (LMR), Lake Michigan (M) and Skamania (SK).

2024 Stocking Summary:

The Wisconsin DNR stocked 50,184 Brook trout fingerlings, 44,545 Brown trout fingerlings, 430,500 Brown trout yearlings, 1,361,857 Chinook salmon fingerlings, 126,632 Coho salmon fingerlings, 390,534 Coho salmon yearlings, and 446,150 Rainbow trout yearlings. US Fish and Wildlife Service stocked 45,132 lake trout yearlings.
