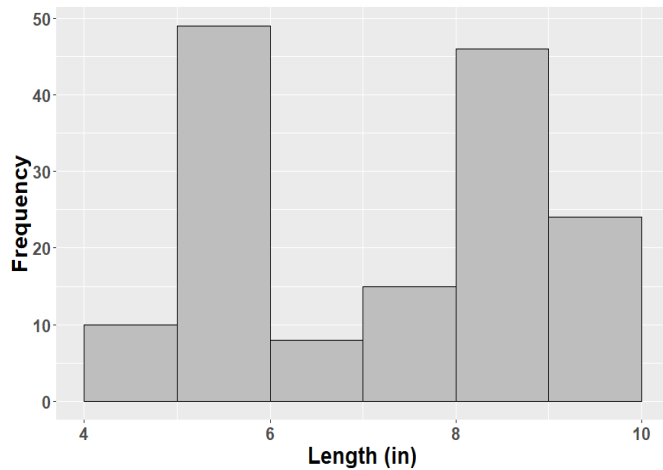

Proportion of 10" Fish	4%

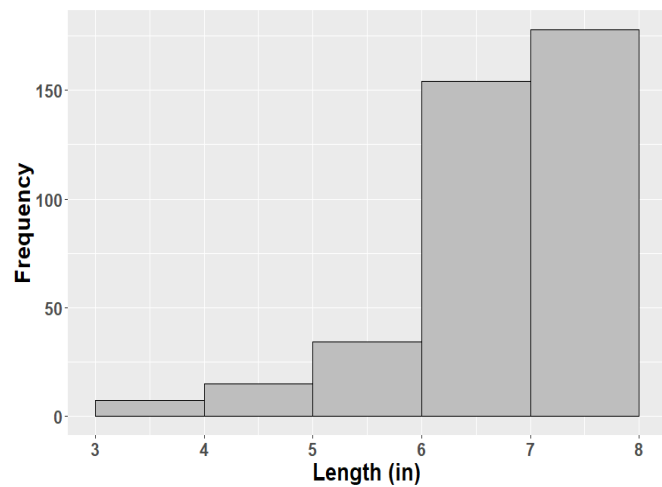
Fishery: High Density, Small Size

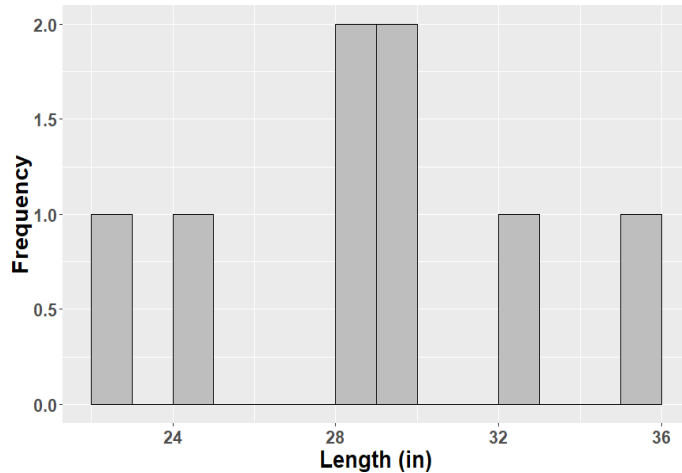

Summary

Lake Wazeda supports a high-density action panfishery but does not have an abundance of quality sized panfish for anglers to harvest. Lake Wazeda water chemistry was not conducive to electrofishing, so we were unable to assess the largemouth bass population. Although captured in low densities, the few northern pike caught were of quality size.
