Introduction

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources requires tournament organizers to hold a permit for fishing tournaments which contain more than 20 boats, more than 100 people, are held with a catch-hold-release format, are held on a trout stream, have more than \$10,000 in prizes awarded, or any tournament for bass that allows culling. Applications

720 Applications were received
42 applications were withdrawn
7 applications were cancelled
1 application was denied
670 applications were approved and held
479 catch-hold-release tournaments (71.5%)
121 catch and keep tournaments (18%)
135 immediate release tournaments (20%)

Notable Results

127 more tournaments were held in 2021 than in 2021; an increase of 23.4% from 2020 to 2021.

Prize value awarded increased by \$222,063 (8%) from 2020 to 2021.

Number of largemouth and smallmouth bass registered increased by 935 (3%) and walleye increased by 5,847 (58.5%) from 2020 to 2021.

Note: The COVID pandemic may have led to a significant decrease in tournaments occurring in 2020.




Figure 2: Species summary for fishing tournaments from 2009 – 2021


