Hi Betsy –

Sorry I didn't get back to you sooner.

My comments don't fit the Comment Form categories so I'll just explain and see if it is appropriate for your project.

Our issues are more specific to public notifications. Since it's a remote area and people visiting the Kickapoo Valley Reserve and Wildcat Mountain State Park are unfamiliar with the ups and downs of the Kickapoo River we are trying to find ways to notify them. The two USGS gauging stations – Ontario and La Farge – are important but the location of the Ontario gauge misses a significant volume from the Brush Creek watershed west of Ontario. I've discussed it with USGS and they can't relocate the gauge or it would be of no use to Ontario residents. They've also provided estimates for a real-time gauge below the Brush Creek impact and it's cost prohibitive.

We're now encouraging visitors to subscribe to the NIXLE alert system via Vernon County Emergency Management. Hopefully that will help. We had to use it already on Friday, May 4th as water was over the roads and in the campsites along the Kickapoo. Hope we're done with that for the year.

Please let me know if you have other suggestions for public notification issues.

Unfortunately we didn't receive notification of the Vernon County meeting so I am contacting you to see if there is another opportunity to participate in the discussion?

Following the Flash Flood in July of 2017, we had interesting dialogue with the National Weather Service-La Crosse and USGS regarding the emergency notification systems. The Kickapoo Reserve Management Board has provided funding for the gauging station on the Kickapoo River in La Farge for almost 20 years. The gauging station in Ontario is equally important and may be improved according to USGS. Given the popularity of the Kickapoo River for recreation, flood risks are a significant safety issue for us in dealing with the public.
