Stakeholder Comment & Response Summary

Why did we update the handbook?

The Timber Sale Handbook is updated every 2 years to incorporate and codify any approved polices and guidance that have occurred since the previous update.

Summary of Process

The Timber Sale Handbook was posted for a 21-day public comment period on the DNR Division of Forestry's "Stakeholder Input Opportunities for Forestry documents" webpage from April 3, 2024 through April 24, 2024.
