The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is seeking stakeholder input on proposed changes to the Public Forest Lands Handbook, which focus on program guidelines for department lands, county forests and Good Neighbor Authority (GNA) processes.

Why Are We Updating This Handbook?

The primary reason we are updating is the entire handbook gets updated every 2 years to review current process/procedures, incorporate approved policy changes, update language, improve clarification, process and fix broken links. The major updates at this time include new internal review language for County Forest lands and Department managed lands, revised chapter content to improve consistency, and GNA updates.

- 150-1 Insertion of cut Chapter 140 "compartment map" content.
- 220-2 Sustainable Forestry Grant preferences updated to reflect NR rule.
- 300 Minor wordsmithing, no guidance changes.
- 310 Updates to reflect current guidance on regeneration projects and associated funding.
- 320-2 Better clarity on existing FRM guidance.
- 330 Completely new Chapter for Internal Reviews on Department managed lands (codifying what FIT approved prior).
- 331 Completely new Chapter for Internal Reviews on County Forest lands (codifying what WCFA/FIT approved prior).
