## Notice of Appeal Rights

If you believe that you have a right to challenge this decision, you should know that Wisconsin Statutes and administrative rules establish time periods within which requests to review Department decisions must be filed. For judicial review of a decision pursuant to ss. 227.52 and 227.53 , Wis. Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to file your petition with the appropriate circuit court and serve the petition on the Department. Such petition for judicial review shall name the Department of Natural Resources as the respondent. To request a contested case hearing pursuant to s. 227.42, Wis. Stats., you have 30 days after the decision is mailed, or otherwise served by the Department, to serve a petition for hearing on the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources. The filing of a request for a contested case hearing is not a prerequisite for judicial review and does not extend the 30-day period for filing a petition for judicial review.
All contested case hearing petitions must be made in accordance with s. NR 2.05(2), Wis. Adm. Code, must identify the grounds for the petition and the desired modification or change to the decision and must include specific information demonstrating the following:

1. The substantial interest of the petitioner which is injured in fact or threatened with injury by Department action or inaction;
2. That there is no evidence of legislative intent that this interest is not to be protected;
3. That the injury to the petitioner is different in kind or degree from injury to the general public caused by Department action or inaction; and
4. That there is a dispute of material fact. (You must specify the disputed facts). This notice is provided pursuant to s. 227.48(2), Wis. Stats.

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## DESIGNATION OF LANDING PORTS

Commercial fishers are required to fish from designated ports in accordance with s. NR 25.18, Wis. Adm. Code, which states:
Fish and fish parts caught in commercial fishing operations and kept by commercial fishers for sale or other use shall be brought to shore in Wisconsin to one of no more than 2 ports designated by the licensee on his or her Great Lakes commercial fishing license application for open water operations and to one of no more than 2 ports selected by the licensee from a list of ports designated for ice fishing operations from the following Wisconsin primary or secondary ports and unloaded and transported by land, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the department or in the case of an emergency, following notice to the nearest U.S. coast guard station.
